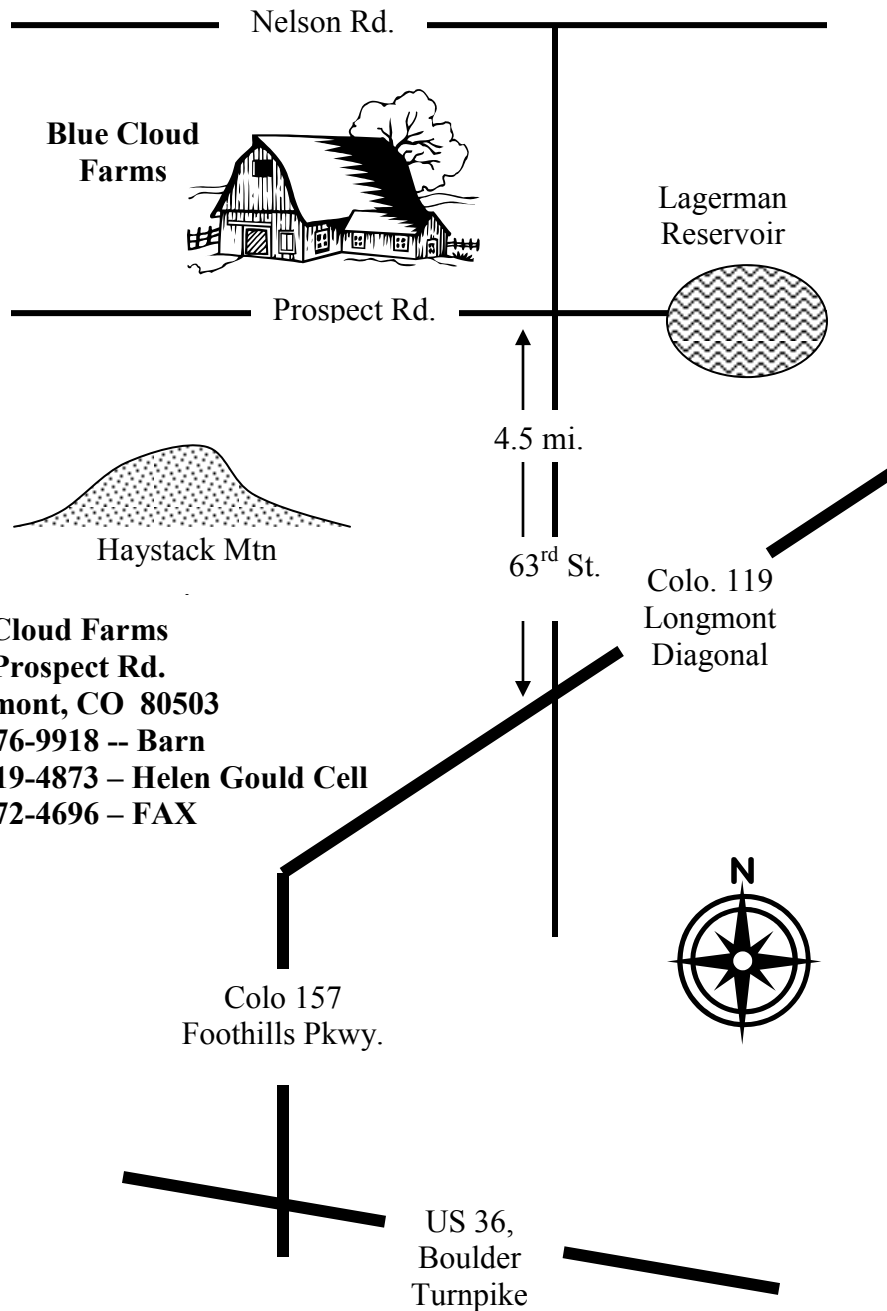

## REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

The Blue Cloud Farms show will in no way be responsible for any loss or accident which may occur by fire or otherwise and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor hold the Blue Cloud Farms Show harmless for any damage or loss that may occur to any animals, vehicles, or persons.

### CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Every class offered herein that is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book and CHJA Specifications will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. In all classes wherein the rules of the USEF Rule Book and CHJA Specifications do not apply, the show management shall settle any dispute or question that may arise and management's decision shall be final. Exhibitors and other participants here, as a condition of admission, consent to such method of settlement.

### FEES AND AWARDS

- There will be a \$30.00 charge for returned checks and accounts must be paid in full within ten (10) days in cash or suitable equivalent.
- A trophy and six (6) ribbons will be awarded for each class. Division championships will be awarded.

Note: The Junior/Adult Amateur Division will be split if entries warrant, and separate championships given.

Note: The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any classes if, in its opinion, the entries so warrant.

### REFUNDS

No refunds will be given unless accompanied by a veterinarian's scratch.

### OTHER

- All dogs must be leashed.
- Entries may be made on the day of the show.
- A one-minute gate and/or dotted line will be used if it becomes necessary.
- Classes will be held in the south outdoor arena.
- EMT will be present for schooling and the duration of the horse show.

### SCHOOLING

- Regulated schooling will start at 6:30 a.m. and continue until 8:00 a.m. and will be permitted in designated areas ONLY. Management will supervise.
- Hard hats, and shoes or boots with a distinctive heel, must be worn at all times by all exhibitors or riders while on horseback anywhere on the show grounds. Juniors must wear headgear which meets the USEF standards with harnesses secured.
- Courses will be posted and available at the north outdoor arena one hour before the start of classes.
- One-minute gate and dotted line may be enforced.

Contestants who earn 12 points in any CHJA Junior Medal, CHJA Adult Medal, Col. R.L. Robertson Medal, Columbine Junior Medal, Columbine Adult Medal, CHJA Pony Medal, or Ruth C. Ayres Medal will qualify for the medals finals of that medal. Points are based on ***the number of entries completing the course*** and will be awarded as follows:

**CHJA Amateur Certification**

As an amateur exhibitor, I understand that any adult who is advertised as a trainer or instructor for horse show purposes; or who regularly acts as a trainer, assistant trainer, and/or instructor for horse show purposes; or who otherwise conducts himself/herself as a professional for horse show purposes; whether or not he/she receives remuneration; is ineligible to ride in any CHJA Group 2 or Group 3 classes which are limited to amateur or beginner riders and is ineligible to ride in any CHJA Medals. An individual who is in possession of a USEF Amateur Card rides under the respective National Federation rules at all CHJA approved shows. I further understand that if I am found to be in violation of my CHJA amateur eligibility, I am subject to the sanctions listed in Rule 5.3 of the CHJA Rules.
