HORSE SHOW RULES AND INFORMATION

1. Entries

ONE HORSE PER ENTRY BLANK

Entries mailed or faxed must be received by **Wednesday, July 14, 2010** to avoid late fees. No money is needed with your entry, but you must have a signed open check or cash to pick up your number.

2. Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Horse Show Management will, in no case, be responsible for loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, CHJA, its Directors and employees, the Town of Estes Park and Stanley Field harmless for any loss or accident to his horse, horses, or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause(s).

3. All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees, buildings or others properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.

4. All bills for veterinary, farrier and feed services are due and payable during the show.

5. There will be a \$50.00 fee charged for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 5 days to be paid in full by cash or cash equivalent.

6. Stalls will be available to Half Penny exhibitors on Tuesday, July 20, 2010 and are to be vacated Thursday, July 22, 2010. ANYONE OCCUPYING STALLS PRIOR TO TUESDAY WILL BE CHARGED \$50/DAY/STALL. Please indicate on your entry blank if you plan to stay over for the Copper Penny Horse Show.

7. Group stabling is available using the "Block Stabling Form" **PLEASE USE ONE COMMON NAME WHEN RESERVING GROUP STALLS AND TURN IN ONE FORM PER GROUP.** The West Barn stalls are not available unless an existing reservation has been made through the Estes Park Hunter/Jumper Festival Shows.

8. Trainer splits must be done by the trainer personally in the Horse Show Office. Splits must be done By 3:00 pm Wednesday, July 21 or before any of the trainers customers have closed out.

9. Safety and Schooling:

Schooling will be scheduled by the Horse Show Manager. Schooling at other times is prohibited. The USEF protective headgear rules will be enforced. In addition, proper footwear with distinctive heels must be worn at all times by exhibitors and riders in the schooling area or on the show grounds.

10. Pets

Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Animal Control officials will be called if necessary.

11. Miscellaneous:

Back-to-back rounds will be allowed and are encouraged.

Management may impose a one-minute gate and/or a posted order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.

Each class will award a first place prize and ribbons through sixth place.

Champion and Reserve Champion will be offered for all divisions.

Show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class or classes should it be deemed in the best interest of the show.

Show management reserves the right to substitute officials should it be necessary.

All classes offered will be conducted in accordance with the 2010 CHJA Bylaws, Rules & Specifications, except as superseded by rule changes published in the CHJA Newsletter or on the CHJA Web Site.

United States Equestrian Federation Rules will govern in all instances, except where CHJA specifications adjust for local situations.

Specifications per CHJA Rule 8.5 I:

To be shown over 8-10 fences at the maximum height of 2'9". Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as brush, wall, in-and-out, oxer, post and rails, gate, aiken, bank, coop, and panels. Management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads as competition warrants. Course should simulate riding over trappy hunt country and should include handy options such as: tight turns, different track options, clever options for jump approaches, hand gallop a jump, trot a lowered obstacle, lead over an obstacle, halt and or back, open gate while mounted, dismount and mount. Will be judged on performance and soundness. To be judged on safe jumping style, brilliance of pace, and handiness of round. Open to Juniors, Amateurs and Professionals. Winners at each show will receive a special prize provided by the Arapahoe Hunt. All participants in this class will be given an Arapahoe Hunt button. Points will accumulate throughout the competition year, and the winner will be awarded the Arapahoe Hunter Derby Trophy at the CHJA Year End Award Ceremony as well as a one-year membership to the Arapahoe Hunt. Points will not be included for purposes of determining other year end hunter awards.

Class 401 EQUINE PRODUCTIONS HALF PENNY MINI PRIX

Entry Fee \$70.00

Prize Money \$1000.00 if there are more than 6 entries.

For 5 or less entries, the prize money is \$500.00.

Prize money divided as follows:

30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%

To be conducted and scored under USEF Table II, 2.2 A/B – Time First Jump Off.

Fences 3'6" – 3'9"

To show in this class a horse must enter and complete at least two of the offered jumper classes at the 2010 Halfpenny Horse Show.

Ribbons through 8th place.

Each competitor will jump one round of approximately 12-14 fences from 1.07-1.15 M (3'6" to 3'9") in height with spreads from 3' to 4'. Water obstacles may be included in the course. The first round and first round jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults received over the course and any penalties for exceeding the time allowed to complete the course. In the event of equality of faults after the first round, for first place only, there will be one jump-off in which time will decide and jump-off faults will decide. All other ties will be determined by time in the first round.

In ties for other than first place, the prize money will be added together and divided equally; riders will draw for ribbons.

Riders are required to wear black, dark blue, dark green or scarlet coats; white shirts with tie, stocks or choker; white, buff or canary breeches, and hunt caps.

The order of go will be drawn at 9:00 a.m. Thursday.
