### **Footing & Rings**

Two indoor arenas, one outdoor all with sand mix footing.

**Numbers:** Each entrant must wear their assigned number clearly displayed and may be disqualified without it. Please return all numbers to the show office upon completion of the competition.

### **Awards and Championships**

All classes- prize for 1st, ribbons through 6<sup>th</sup> unless otherwise stated.

Hunter Championships and Reserves will be awarded according to CHJA Rule 8.2C-D. Jumper Ch. and Res. shall be awarded according to CHJA Rule 9.1C. Equitation Ch. And Res. Ch. will be awarded according to CHJA Rule 10.1c-d.

Division Championships will be offered for the following divisions:

**Hunter:** Schooling, beg. open, beg. amateur, beg. Junior, short stirrup, green, evergreen, open, amateur, junior.

**Equitation:** Beg. Adult, Beg. Junior 12-17, beg. Junior 11 & under, CHJA 11 & under.

**Jumper:** Puddle, Schooling, Low, JR/AA, Open.

### **Changes and Cancellations**

Show Management reserves the right to decline any entry or post entry at their discretion and to return any fees before or during the show without liability. Further, it reserves the right to do all

things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. If there are less than 6 entries the division may be cancelled or combined.

### **Schooling/Warm up**

Warm-up is offered prior to the start of the show each morning from 7 am to 20 min prior to the start of the ring. *Warm up time is extended to horses entered at the horse show only!* Attire is informal; however, protective head gear and boots with a heel are mandatory for anyone mounted.

Management/course designer reserves the right to change any jump or course post schooling and prior to the start of show for safety.

Schooling may be monitored for safety and numbers may be limited. Dangerous riders may be excused from the ring.

### **Returned checks**

There will be a \$50.00 charge for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 10 days to be paid in full by cash or certified funds.

### **Stabling-**

All stabled horses must have a current coggins. 303-520-4410

### **Fees**

Regular classes' \$18/class, Classics and Medals \$22/class.

EMT fee \$15 per rider

Office Fee \$15 per number issued

After office closed (3 pm day prior to start of show) fee \$25 will be enforced.

\$10 Grounds fee to all non-stabled horses

**Entry Procedures** Entries should be faxed (303-265-9222) or mailed to: Spring into Columbine II, 6106 S. Ponds Way, Littleton, CO 80123. Any entry received after 3 pm the day prior to the start of the show will be charged a \$25 fee NO EXCEPTIONS! Please note, we will not receive or accept faxes after 3 on Friday

**Scratches & Refunds:** No charges made on entries scratched prior to 3 pm the day before the show. Any entry scratched after the number has been picked up will forfeit the Office fee of \$15.

### **Class Specifications**

**Warm-up-** Open to all horses and ponies. Fences will match currently running division heights. Courses may be changed during the show. Warm-up will be closed during flat and other specified classes. Participants will be judged as hunter rounds and given a numeric score. Scores receiving 78-100 earn a blue ribbon, scores of 72-77 a red.

### **Regulations**

- Back-to-back rounds allowed and encouraged.
- No judges will be allowed at the end of the division at the regular class fee with management approval only.
- Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on Colorado State University Equine Center.
- Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
- No schooling allowed on Friday. **Schooling starts at 7am**
- Only one horse per entry form.
- A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show.
- Show location is a NON SMOKING FACILITY – Strictly enforced, Please respect this!
- Trailers are to park on the dirt parking lot. The asphalt lot is for passenger cars only
