#### Things you may want to know.

1. All fees should be made payable to Cottonwood Riding Club

- 2. No refunds will be given unless accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate.
- 3. Stalls will be available for a fee of \$50.00 per day/night. The stalls will be bedded. Please call Tara to reserve. Just noting it on your entry form is not adequate, you must call. Tara Hieb 303-791-7656
- 4. Any returned checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A bounced check fee of \$40 must be included.

#### Regulations:

- 1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
- 2. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on the show grounds.
- 3. Only one horse per entry form
- 4. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
- 5. Dogs are not allowed at this facility. PLEASE leave them at home!

Awards: Blue Ribbons for clear jumper rounds. Red ribbons for jumpers with 1-4 faults. Yellow ribbons for jumpers with 5-12 faults
