

Location & Directions 6000 Main Street, Littleton 80125 (use zip code for navigator)

From Santa Fe Drive turn west on Kelley Avenue, Cross two sets of railroad tracks and barn will be on the left. Kelley Avenue is 2.4 miles south of Titan road. Watch for the "Louviers" sign. (303-519-2538 for more detailed directions if needed). *Make sure to use the zip code when map questing.*

Liability

Fox Hill Equestrian Center and In Stride, Inc will in no way be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it will be a condition of entry that each participant shall hold harmless the show and its management for any loss or accident to their animals or equipment. The show will not be responsible for any articles of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed, or stolen; and will not be responsible or liable for injury sustained in any way to participants, spectators, employee or any other party. Any damage caused to Fox Hill Equestrian property will be billed to the offending party. This includes exposure to infectious diseases. Anyone not following the Covid Protocol will be asked to leave the facility and no refund will be given.

Under Colorado Law, an equine professional is not liable for injury to or death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Section 13-21-119 Colorado Revised Statutes.

Dogs:

Dogs must be on leash AT ALL TIMES. At no time should any dog be in the arena or its entrance.

Footing & Rings

All arenas consist of arena grade sand and arena sand and fiber/rubber. The open field is also available for schooling and lunging. Fox Hill Equestrian Center is located in a river valley and has naturally sandy footing.

Numbers:

Each entrant must wear their assigned number clearly displayed and may be disqualified without it. Please return all numbers to the show office upon completion of the competition.

Awards / Championships/Payouts

- All classes- prize for 1st, ribbons through 6th, unless stated otherwise.
- Hunter Championships and Reserves will be awarded according to CHJA Rule 8.2C-D. Jumper Champion and Reserve Champion shall be awarded according to CHJA Rule 9.1C. Equitation Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded according to CHJA Rule 10.1C-D.
- Any classes offering money must have 6 entries to pay. Award money will be applied to any show fees. Any remainder will be issued a check.

Changes and Cancellations

Show Management reserves the right to decline any entry or post entry at their discretion and to return any fees before or during the show without liability. Further, Show Management reserves the right to do all things

Schooling/Warm up

Management/course designer reserves the right to change any jump or course post-schooling and prior to the start of show.

Schooling will be monitored by the Steward, Gate Person, and staff of Fox Hill for safety and numbers will be limited. Dangerous riders may be excused from the ring. Some jumps may be off limits to schooling. Schooling is open 1.5 hours prior to start of the first ring start time and will close 30 min before start time.

Returned checks

There will be a \$50.00 charge for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 10 days to be paid in full by cash or certified funds.

Stabling

Stall fees are \$40 per day. We have limited stalls. For stall reservations and arrival arrangements you must call Liz Tuttle at 303-520-4410. Marking it on the entry does not reserve a stall, you must contact Liz!

Stall reservations without completed entries will be released to the next person on the wait list on the July 5th closing date. Stalls are available from Friday through Sunday.

Fees

- Regular classes \$30/class
- EMT fee \$15 per rider
- Office Fee \$30 per number issued
- \$20 grounds fee to all non-stabled horses
- Stalls \$40 per day
 - \$25 after entry deadline. Late entries are not guaranteed. Call to check if we are accepting entries after 5 p.m. Monday July 5th.
- NO DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES ACCEPTED
- Non-showing horses must pay EMT, Office and a stable/grounds fee and are only accepted on a space available basis. Anyone violating this will be fined \$110 per non-compliance.
- Anyone ejected from the show due to noncompliance with our policies will not receive a refund.

Entries are first come, first served and not guaranteed. You will receive an acceptance email if your entry is received and complete. Once we are at capacity, we will be closing entries and starting a wait list, even if it is prior to the closing date.

Any entry received after the closing date of Monday July 5th will be accepted only on a space available basis and will be assessed a \$25 late entry fee.

Scratches & Refunds

No charges will be applied to entries scratched prior to the closing date or if your spot can be filled from the waiting list. Any entry scratched after the number has been picked up will forfeit the Office fee of \$30.

Class Specifications

Warm-up

Warm-up is open to all horses and ponies entered in the show. Fences will match currently running division heights. Courses may be changed during the show. Warm-up will be closed during flat and other specified classes. Participants will be judged as hunter rounds unless otherwise noted and given a numeric score. Scores receiving 78-100 earn a blue ribbon; scores of 72-77 earn a red ribbon. Multiple warm-ups are permissible with management approval and payment of an additional class fee but must be ridden before the division classes. Jumper warm up is judged as a blue ribbon clear round.

<u>CHJA 2'3-2'6" hunters</u> (previously Schooling Hunters) is an open division

Out Reach 2'6" is open to amateurs. Professionals may ride as a no-judge only

<u>CHJA 2'6-2'9" Hunter</u>. Open division (previously Beg. Open hunters)

CHJA Low Adults 2'6-2'9 (previously Beg. Amateur)

CHJA Low Children's 2'6-2'9" (previously Beg. Junior)

Arapahoe Hunter Derby To be shown over 8-10 fences at the maximum height of 2'9". Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as brush, wall, in and out, oxer, post and rails, gate, aiken, bank, coop and panels. Course should simulate riding over trappy hunt country and should include handy options such as: tight turns, different track options, clever options for jump approaches, hand gallop a jump, trot a lowered obstacle, lead over an obstacle, halt and/or back, open gate while mounted, dismount and mount. Will be judged on performance and soundness. To be judged on safe jumping style, brilliance of pace and handiness of round. Open to Juniors, Amateurs and Professionals. Points will accumulate throughout the competition year and the winner will be awarded the Arapahoe Hunter Derby trophy at the CHJA awards banquet. Points will not be included for purposes of determining other year end hunter awards.

Regulations and information

- Covid-19 procedures must be followed (see pg. 6)
- Back-to-back rounds are allowed and encouraged.
- "No- judges" will be allowed at the regular class fee with management approval only.
- Any division age splits, or combinations will be determined by entry numbers the preceding evening at the conclusion of the show day. We will not split based on same day adds...no exceptions.
- All warm up classes must be ridden before the division classes. Warm ups are allowed prior to, but not during the medal classes.

- ASTM Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on Fox Hill Equestrian Center property.
- Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
- Only one horse allowed per entry form.
- Paddock Master (gate) has control and jurisdiction of schooling and the ring. <u>Rudeness or non-compliance will not be tolerated</u>. Entry to the show will be denied to anyone who does not follow this.
- A one-minute gate and/or a posted order-of-go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show.
- Fox Hill is a NON-SMOKING FACILITY. This is strictly enforced, please respect this! NO BUTTS ON THE GROUND PLEASE!
- All competitors are requested to respect the generosity and use of the facility and to please help KEEP IT CLEAN! Please pay attention to all signs and follow all posted rules and recommendations.

 There is no penalty for scratching or changing your entry so send your entries early to avoid the nonnegotiable late fee. We can only adjust classes for age division splits if we have entries in a timely fashion complete with classes and ages.

Health Requirements-

All horses must present proof of a negative Coggins Test dated within 1 year to the show secretary to <u>be included</u> with your entry. Email certificates to:

Liztuttle@wildblue.net. We can keep certificates on file for the season if the paperwork is valid for the duration of the season.

We reserve the right to add additional requirements in the event of any local disease outbreaks that would necessitate a health certificate or health check at the gate. Any changes will be posted here.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL-All in attendance must read.-Please see our In Stride FB page for the latest protocol as things change rapidly and we reserve the right to change our policy.

*Please remember that you are a guest of Fox Hill and we take Covid-19 very seriously. We are trusting you to follow the below procedures in order keep yourself and others at a minimized risk. Exhibitors and trainers, you are responsible for making sure everyone has read and complies with these provisions.

- Entries accepted electronically through horseshowing.com or emailed Liztuttle@wildblue.net
- Please take your temperature in the morning and scratch your entry if you have a fever. Do not come if you have Covid-19 symptoms or have been exposed to a confirmed case of Covid-19.
- We request that you wash your hands immediately upon arrival and frequently throughout the day. Water and soap will be provided.
- Everyone should be mindful of space and keep a minimum of 6 ft away from any other person whenever possible.
- Trainer packets are to be picked up in the office by 1
 representative and will only be handed out when all entries
 have a check attached. (trainer may leave a barn check and
 will be responsible for any open accounts)
- Main barn is closed and is for boarders only. The indoor arena is to be accessed only through the north entrance.
- Limited concessions and ring side water will be offered at this show.
- Rotations will set up with the Gate Person on a first come first served basis. If you miss your rotation, or do not sign up for one, you will ride at the end of the division.

- The Gate Person has complete authority of the arena entrance and will manage the entrance to limit numbers.
- All ringside watching should be done as spaced out as possible. When you are done showing, please vacate the facility.
- Schooling will be supervised and limited for safety. Schooling breaks will be offered as needed throughout the day.
