FRIDAY SCHOOLING:

Move-in begins at 10:00 am, Friday. Ticketed Schooling will be available from 1:00 pm until 5:00 pm on Friday. Schooling spots must be reserved in advance by the trainer .

There must be a minimum of 15 horses signed up by the deadline or Friday schooling will be canceled. Notice of cancelation will be sent to those who have reservations. Schooling reservations must be in writing by email or text. **No phone reservations**. The names of the riders/ horses must be provided on schooling day. Sessions will cost \$30.00 per horse. Time of sessions will be determined by the number of horses waiting.

Stalls will be available for a fee of \$50.00 per day. The stalls will not be bedded. Bedding will be available for purchase. Outside shavings are NOT allowed.

REGULATIONS:

- 1. Back to back rounds are allowed and encouraged.
- 2. "No-judge" rides will be allowed if time permits and at management discretion.
- 3. ASTM certified helmets must be worn at all times by all riders while on Denver Polo Club property.
- 4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 am until thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the ring. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.

5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class should it be in the best interest of the show.

6. Only one (1) horse per entry form.

7. A one (1) minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.

8. Pets must be on a leash at all times! \$100 fine paid by owner/exhibitor for any loose pets caught by management or facility staff.

9. Warm Ups will be Blue/Red and may be entered multiple times if time permits. Hunter Blue Ribbons are awarded for a score of eighty (80) or higher; Red ribbons for a score of seventy-two (72) to seventy-nine (79). Jumper Warm Ups are awarded a Blue Ribbon for a clear round.

ENTRY PROCEDURES:

Entries must be received by 5:00 pm Wednesday, September 21, 2022 to avoid the Post Entry Fee. After picking up your number you are financially responsible for your entries. No extra charges will be assessed for adding classes as long as you add them prior to riding in the class. **Second rounds of Classics may not be scratched after the first round has been ridden.**

- · Checks made out to CHJA. Also accepting Venmo or cash. NO CREDIT CARDS are accepted at this show.
- Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A \$50.00 NSF fee will be charged.
- Non-showing horses must pay an office fee, EMT fee, and a grounds fee.



Directions:

From Santa Fe Drive, turn west on Airport Road. Follow Airport Road for approximately 1/2 mile, over the bridge to Airport Road (again). Turn left on Airport Road and follow it past the large white farm house for approximately 1/4 mile. You have reached Denver Polo Club when you see the large iron gates on the left. Go straight past those large iron gates and take the next left into the property. Follow the drive around to the barn area.



CCCF will be held at the <u>Of Horse You Can Arena</u> at the Denver Polo Club.

Biosecurity Requirements at Denver Polo Club

- A current negative Coggins test.
- Health certificate dated by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of arriving at the venue** WNV, EEE, WEE, Tetanus, and Rabies are strongly recommended.
- ALL DOCUMENTATION MUST BE IN THE HORSE'S SHOW NAME. You will need to present documentation to pick up your numbers.
- · Be prepared to show documentation at any time during the show.

Hunter and Equitation Classics - Entry Fee - \$30.00/round: The \$200.00 Hunter and Equitation Classics will

be a two (2)- round format. Each round is scored and awarded placings 1st - 6th. Ribbons, a prize for

1^s place and year-end points are given for each round. The scores for each round are then added

together, and the overall winners are determined by the total scores. The overall Classic winners will receive ribbons and a prize for 1st place.

Hunter Classic winners will receive prize money for 1st - 5th places: \$100.00 - \$50.00 - \$25.00 - \$15.00 - \$10.00.

Equitation Classic winners will receive prizes for placings 1st -6th.

Bonus year-end points for the overall Classics are awarded through 12th place: 1st place 20 points; 2nd place 16 points; 3rd place 14 points; 4th place 12 points; 5th place 10 points; 6th place 8 points; 7th place 6 points; 8th place 5 points; 9th place 4 points; 10th place 3 points; 11th place 2 points; and 12th place 1 point.

Jumper Divisions and Stake Classes - Entry Fee - \$30.00/round Jumper Divisions will be a three (3) round format, with the third round offered as a \$200.00 stake class. Each round will be awarded placings 1st - 6th, with year-end points given through 6th place. A prize will be awarded for 1st place. The stake class* will receive ribbons for 1st- 6th place, and a prize for first place. Prize money will be distributed for 1st -5th places: \$100.00 - \$50.00 - \$25.00 - \$15.00 - \$10.00.

Stake Class winners will receive bonus year-end points through 12th place: 1st place 20 points; 2nd place 16 points; 3rd place 14 points; 4th place 12 point,; 5th place 10 points; 6th place 8 points; 7th place 6 points; 8th place 5 points; 9th place 4 points; 10th place 3 points; 11th place 2 points; and 12th place 1 point.

Champion and Reserve Champion Prizes and Bonus Points will also be given in the Jumper Division.

Medal Classes will receive ribbons for 1st-6th place as well as applicable medal points, a CHJA Medal and a prize for 1st place.

\$200 Owen O'Meara Memorial Pro/Jr-Am Derby (2'9" OR 3') - Entry Fee - \$35.00: To qualify, horses must have competed in at least one (1) of the hunter over-fences classes. This is a two (2) round class. One (1) round must be ridden by a professional, and the other must be ridden by a junior or amateur. The first round will be a classic hunter round to be shown over a minimum of eight (8) jumps. The second round will be a handy hunter style course. Either rider may ride either course, but the switch of riders after the first round must take place in a designated 'change box' inside the arena. One (1) groom may assist in the rider switch, with a change of saddle is permitted. The switch must not exceed sixty (60) seconds, and there may be NO communication between riders. The switch will be monitored by an official timekeeper. After sixty (60) seconds, one (1) full point per second over the time allowed will be deducted from the overall score. Each round will receive a numerical score, and the total combined score will be used to determine placings. Two (2) separate derbies will be offered based on the height of the jumps - one (1) derby with jumps set at 2'9" and a separate derby with jumps set at 3'. The same horse/rider combination may only compete in ONE (1) derby that is applicable to the jump height of the hunter classes they competed in. Winners will receive prize money for 1" - 5" places: \$100.00 - \$25.00 - \$15.00 - \$10.00

Please note: There must be a minimum of five (5) horses competing in each Classic or Stake for prize money to be awarded.
