CHECK LIST

- All horses/ponies on grounds must have a health certificate within 30 (watch CSC Facebook, Instagram, and coloradoshowcircuit.com as this may be changed to a 10 day should there be any health concerns in the area)
- Must also have vaccination record with vaccines given within the last 180 days but no more recent than the previous 7 days
- Must have proof of negative coggins
- All trainers, riders, and OWNERS OF RECORD must be active members or pay the show pass fee and MUST have completed SafeSport training. We will not be allowed to let you participate if this has not been completed prior to the start of showing.
- Horses must have a USEF Recording number or USHJA Registration number, this number must be active for points to count
- Horses in the Junior Hunters must have a measurement card. If they do not, please notify the office by 3:00 Friday afternoon so that we may schedule an official measurement with the steward and vet prior to the start of classes.
- Juniors who have aged out, make sure that when you renew your membership that you choose Amateur or Pro as you must have an Amateur card to compete in the Adult Amateurs or Amateur Owners.
- All memberships and show passes must be done online prior to the show. SHOWS ARE NO LONGER ALLOWED TO PROCESS MEMBERSHIPS OR SHOW PASSES.

Rules and Regulations

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Freisian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA Beginner Novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Colorado. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation, and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or. The Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product that they may not be used in such as way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

USHJA HORSE REGISTRATION

All horses competing in federation non-breed restricted competitions must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms. Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed online or using the Horse Registration application form. See HU101.1 and JP100.2 of the USEF Rule Book. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license to operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hoverboards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

ENTRIES

Competitors are encouraged to submit email their entries to coloradoshowcircuit@gmail.com, scan/pdf preferred but photographs will be accepted. Mail to: Colorado Show Circuit 7686 Nuthatch Way, Parker CO 80134. Entries received after 5pm, Wednesday, April 26 will be charged a one time fee of \$25 per entry. Entry blanks will be accepted ONLY when signed by the owner or exhibitor's agent, trainer, and rider. Be sure to include the USEF Membership number of your trainer, rider and owner on the entry form. No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order.

BACK NUMBERS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES IN THE SHOW ARENA

All exhibitors in Amateur sections must present their Amateur certification at the office before numbers will be released. Non member fees will be \$45 each to both USEF and USHJA.

MEASUREMENTS

All exhibitors in the Junior Hunter sections must present their measurement cards at the office before numbers will be released. All Junior Hunters who do not possess a current measurement card will be measured with the steward by appointment. If a measurement will be needed please notify the horse show secretary prior to 3pm on Friday.

MANAGEMENT

Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry in accordance with GR914.

Colorado Show Circuit and Front Range Show Stables, the owner, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show.

****THIS WILL BE A CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW AND SHOW GROUNDS****

- + A processing fee of \$50 plus collection fees will be made for any non-negotiable checks
- + Venmo, checks, PayPal, or Zelle are all approved methods of payment
- + All riders must wear ASTM Certified protective headgear while mounted
- + No alterations are to be made to permanent stabling or other facilities by exhibitors
- + No smoking is permitted inside the barn
- + A \$45 haul in fee will be charged to all horses without a stall
- + A \$45 office will be charged to all entry numbers
- + A \$25 EMT fee will be charged to all entry numbers
- + Dogs must be leashed at all times. Per USEF Rule 1301.6 dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance for warning cards.
- + **Schooling will be available from 7 – 8:30 on Sunday morning.**
- + Entry fee plus \$10 will be added to any entry that is added to a class at the gate and not in the office

REFUNDS

+ Refunds will be given in the case of a vet note or if a barn brings an alternate horse/rider combination as a substitution or if the stall can be resold. Once a horse/rider has arrived on property refunds for grounds/stall/office/and medic will not be given.

FEES

Any class without a listed fee is \$35

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness. A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be given in each Hunter section that includes an under saddle class. Three classes with at least 3 completions must be held in order to award champions. Championships will be broken by highest over fences points. Ties in a speed round will stand.

WARM UPS

Provided that the weather is good, we will have the warm up arena outside. Arena is 200x190. In case of inclement weather we will break the class into groups, warm up a group, show them, warm up the next group, show them. This will be done by trainers consulting with the starter on groups.

ARENA DIMENSIONS

The competition arena is indoor with a low dust blend, 200x145.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT

All USEF Life and Senior Active member, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. 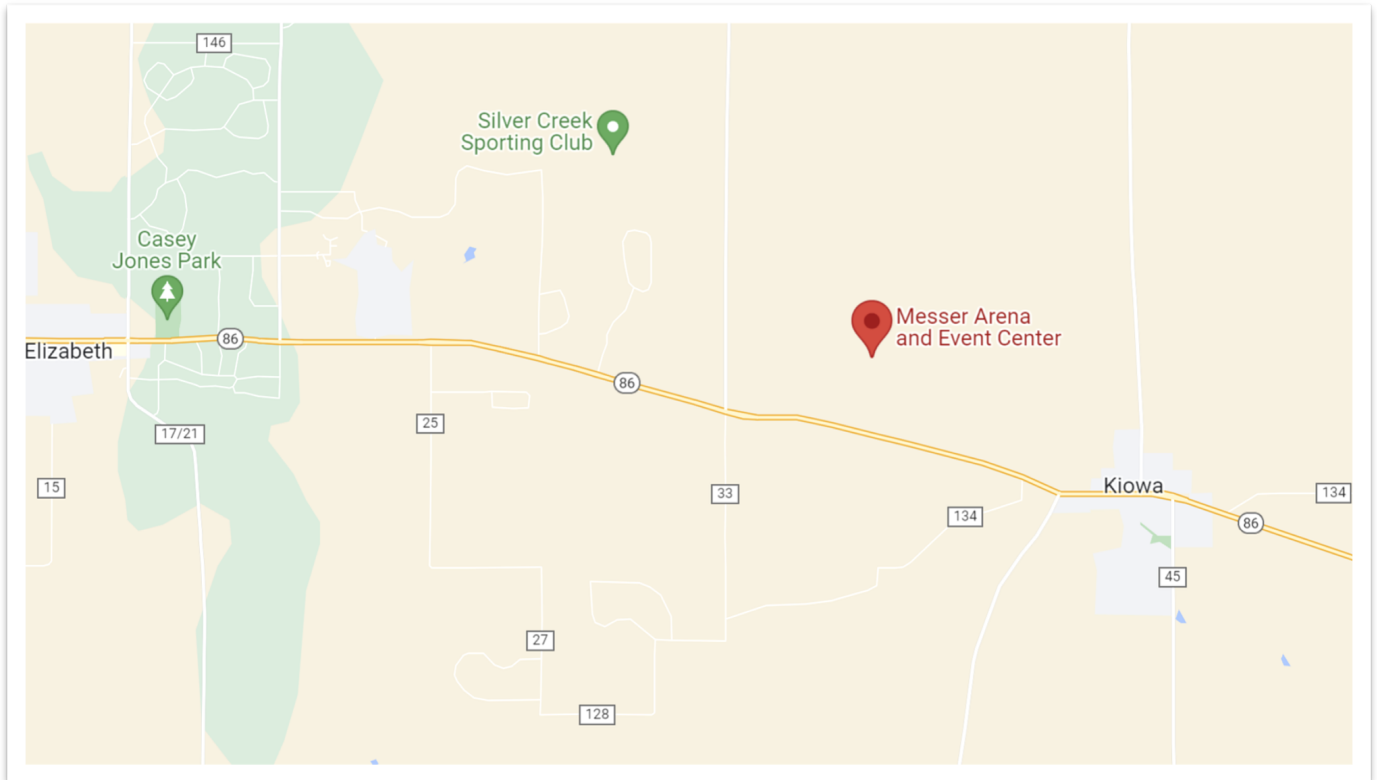

2. Continue on CO-86 East for approximately 12 miles.

4. Turn left onto Co Rd 110 and continue for approximately 2.5 miles.
5. Turn right onto Co Rd 37 and continue for approximately 2 miles.

Open to exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 1.10m or 3'6". Horse/Rider combinations may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 2'9".(Exception: 3' Equitation). Low Adult Hunters and Low Childrens must be combined with fewer than (3) entries in either section.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Fence height 3'. Combinations allowed.

Open to exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. Adult Amateur Hunter riders may not cross enter into any hunter class with fences exceeding 3'6" nor any jumper class with fences exceeding 1.20m (3'11") at the same show. Cross entry restrictions do not apply to the under saddle but any horse entered in the Adult Amateur Under Saddle must be ridden by an Adult Amateur. Horses may cross enter into any other section in which they are eligible. The Horse/Rider combination is restricted from showing in both Amateur Owner and Adult Amateur Hunter sections at the same show. The same Horse/Rider combination competing in the Adult Amateur Hunter may not cross enter into a USHJA International Hunter Derby. If there are fewer than 3 entries in either the Adult Hunters or the Children's Hunters the divisions must be combined.

Class: 65, 66, 67 O/F 68 U/S

LOW CHILDRENS HUNTER

Fence height 2'6"

Open to exhibitors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 1.10m or 3'6". Horse/Rider combinations may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 2'9" (Exception: 3' Equitation). If there are fewer than 3 entries in either Low Children's or the Low Adults then the divisions must be combined.

Entry Fee: \$35 per class

Class: 27, 28 O/F 29 U/S

CHILDRENS HUNTER

Fence height 3'

Fence height 3'. Combinations allowed.

Open to exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. Children's Hunter riders may not cross enter into any hunter class with fences exceeding 3'6" nor any jumper class with fences exceeding 1.20m (3'11") at the same show. Cross entry restrictions do not apply to the under saddle but any horse entered in the Children's Under Saddle must be ridden by an Junior rider. Horses may cross enter into any other section in which they are eligible. The Horse/Rider combination is restricted from showing in both Junior Hunter and Children's Hunter sections at the same show. The same Horse/Rider combination competing in the Children's Hunter may not cross enter into a USHJA International Hunter Derby. If there are fewer than 3 entries in either the Adult Hunters or the Children's Hunters the divisions must be combined. In the event that the Children's Hunter Pony and Children's Hunter Horses are combined, there will be no combinations.

83. T.H.I.S. National Children's Medal

Open to all Junior members of the USEF who have never competed in a National Equitation Final with fences at 3'6 (USEF/Maclay/etc). To be shown over a minimum of eight fences 2'9 to 3' in height. Spreads not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. The top four riders are required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF tests 1 – 19. An open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the first round, with each riders score announced at the completion of their round. Class Fee: \$45

87. Ariat National Adult Medal

Open to all amateur riders except Amateur Owners. Fences 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 hunter fences 2'9 – 3'. Top 4 to return for a test from USEF 1 - 19. See USEF rulebook for more specifications. Class Fee: \$45

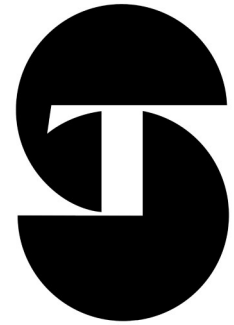

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and CSC Spring ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.

The parties agree that this agreement may be electronically signed. The parties agree that the electronic signatures appearing on this agreement are the same as handwritten signatures for the purposes of validity, enforceability, and admissibility.
