Stalls will be available for a fee of \$40.00 per day. The stalls will not be bedded. Bedding will be available. CHP requires a minimum of 5 bags of shavings per stall. Outside shavings will be allowed, but there will be a \$25.00 Cleaning Fee charged. Horses in stalls with no shavings will be charged a \$25.00 Cleaning Fee. Call Jenny Alsberg at 303 875 6184 to reserve stalls and order bedding.

All fees should be made payable to: CHJA. Fees to be paid at the show--no fees payable in advance.

Regulations

- 1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
- 2. No-judges will be allowed if time permits.
- 3. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on Colorado Horse Park property.
- 4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 am until 30 minutes prior to the start of the ring. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
- 5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class should it be in the best interest of the show.
- 6. Only one horse per entry form.
- 7. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
- 8. There will be a \$50.00 charge for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 5 days to be paid in full by cash or equivalent.
- 9. Pets must be on a leash at all times!
- 10. Non-showing horses must be entered and pay a grounds fee or stall fee, an EMT fee and an office fee.
- 11. Warm Ups will be Blue/Red and may be entered multiple times if time permits. Blue Ribbon awarded for a score of 80 or more, Red ribbon for a score of 72 to 79. Jumper Warm Ups Blue Ribbon Clear Round.

ENTRY PROCEDURES: Entries must be received by 2:00 pm Thursday, September 19 to avoid the Post Entry Fee. If you enter on the day of show, an additional Day Of Show Fee will be charged. On the day of show make any changes before picking up your number. After picking up your number you are financially responsible for your entries. No extra charge for adding classes as long as you add them prior to riding in the class. Classes may **NOT** be added at the gate. You must add and scratch in the office PRIOR to the start of the class or you will be charged. Second rounds of Classics may not be scratched after the first round has been ridden. For Class Specifications, see the CHJA Rulebook. The Rulebook is available online at www.chja.org.

FRIDAY SCHOOLING WILL BE AVAILABLE

Ticketed Schooling will be available from Noon until 6:00 pm Schooling spots must be reserved in advance by the trainer before noon Thursday. All spots reserved will be charged to the trainer and are non-refundable. Trainers may split these to their riders if done so in the show office before 10:00 am Saturday. Even if the trainer does not come to the show these charges will be billed and must be paid. There must be a minimum of 25 horses signed up by the deadline or Friday schooling will be canceled. Notice of cancelation will appear on chja.org . Schooling reservations must be in writing by email or fax.* No phone reservations. The names of the riders/horses must be included for billing purposes. Sessions will cost \$20.00 per horse. Time of sessions will be determined by the number of horses waiting. *coshowentries@gmail.com* or 303 773 8635

POINTS AND PRIZES

The \$200.00 Hunter and Equitation Classics will be a two round format. Each round is scored and placed 1-6, and ribbons, first place prizes and year end points are given for each round. The scores for each round are then added together, and the overall winners are determined by the total scores The overall Classic winners will receive special ribbons and first place prizes. Hunter Classic winners will receive prize money for 1st-5th of \$100.00-\$50.00-\$25.00-\$15.00-10.00. Equitation Classic winners will receive prizes 1-6. Bonus year end points for the overall Classics are awarded to 12th place: 1st 20 pts, 2nd 16pts, 3rd 14pts, 4th 12pts, 5th 10pts, 6th8pts, 7th 6pts, 8th 5pts, 9th 4pts, 10th 3pts, 11th 2pts and 12th 1pt.

Jumper Divisions will be a 3 round format with the third round being a \$200.00 stake class. Each round will be pinned 1st-6th and year end points will be given 1st-6th. Prizes will be given for 1st place. The stake class will receive special ribbons 1st-6th, a prize for first place and prize money for 1-5 of \$100.00-\$50.00-\$25.00-\$15.00 and \$10.00. Stake Class winners will receive bonus points for 1st-12th as noted above. Champion and Reserve Champion Prizes and Bonus Points will also be given in the Jumper Division.

There must be a minimum of 5 horses competing in each Classic or Stake for prize money to be paid.

Medal Classes with receive ribbons 1st-6th, medal qualifying points, a CHJA Medal and prizes for first place.

BIOSECURITY AT THE COLORADO HORSE PARK

Required:

Negative Coggins within one year.

Health Certificate within 5 days. This should include dates of vaccinations no later than 180 days.

Vaccine records stating that EHV 1/4 were administered no later than 180 days prior to the show.

Physical Inspection for VS may be required upon arrival. This will be determined by the Show Vet the week of the show.

ALL DOCUMENTATION MUST BE IN THE HORSE'S SHOW NAME!

No horse can be unloaded until the documentation is presented.

All horses must enter the facility off Bayou Gulch Rd. There will only be one entrance open and it will be the first one you come to across from the church. *No entrance through the top gate on S. Pinery Dr.*

Saturday & Sunday entry 6:00 am -2:00 pm

Entry at any other times is by appointment.


