- 1. Entries close Thursday, June 13th, 7 p.m. for Show I; and Thursday June 20st 7 p.m. for Show II. Late and day of show entries will be accepted with a \$25.00 late fee and \$25 day of show fee.
- 2. All checks should be made payable to 'Cross the Meadow Farm
 There will be a \$50.00 fee for returned checks. Any returned checks must be
 paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days.
- 3. Adds and scratches will be allowed. Show scratches will be refunded; less the cost of any classes completed, office and EMT fees and stall/paddock fees, if applicable.


