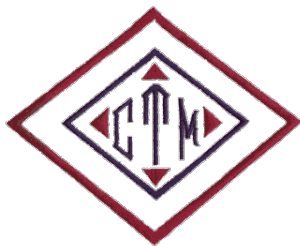

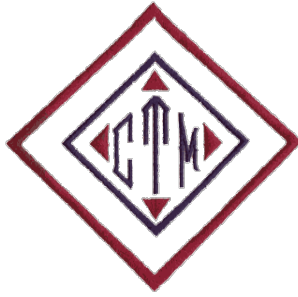

From I-25 heading north, take exit 269B West, and you will be on Highway 14 / Mulberry. Go west a couple miles until Highway 287 / College and turn right. Now traveling north on College, head through town until the street curves towards the west. Just past Jax Farm and Ranch, at the railroad tracks, turn left onto Shields Street. Half a block south, a Four Winds sign marks the entrance on the east side of the road. Follow the driveway past the barn and train tracks for trailer parking.

Rules and Regulations

Show will be run according to CHJA rules & regulations.

1. Entries close Thursday, June 17th, 7 p.m. for Show I; and Thursday June 24th 7 p.m. for Show II. Late and day of show entries will be accepted with a \$25.00 late fee and \$25 day of show fee.
2. All checks should be made payable to 'Cross the Meadow Farm'. There will be a \$50.00 fee for returned checks. Any returned checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days.
3. Adds and scratches will be allowed. Show scratches will be refunded; less the cost of any classes completed, office and EMT fees and stall/paddock fees, if applicable.
4. **Show management reserves the right to cancel, combine, divide, and/or move any classes.**
5. "No judges" will be allowed for hunter classes, time permitting.
6. Stalls will be available for \$45.00/ per day **Show I**, and a limited # of stalls will be available for \$55/day **Show II**. **Shavings will be available for sale Show I and included for Show II. For CTM I Please call Jasmine 970-691-6122 to reserve stalls and shavings**
7. Approved helmets must always be worn while mounted.
8. Champion and Reserve will be awarded in all divisions. First place award and ribbons through 6th, Classics through 12th.
9. A one-minute gate will be imposed if management finds it necessary.
10. Loose pets **will not be allowed**. Please always keep your pets leashed.
11. Please respect our hosts' property and do not throw cigarettes on the ground. Use ash cans provided!
12. **Proper show attire required.** Jumper riders are to wear shirts with collar and sleeves; **Equitation Classic riders are to wear hunt coats.**
13. Non showing horses will be charged an office and EMT fee and stall /grounds fee.

Special Classes

Dion Dana Memorial Equitation Classic - Sat.

June 19th

Fences 2'6"-2'-9"

Open to all Beginner Amateur and Beginner Junior riders. Riders must have entered and competed in at least two Equitation over fences classes (Medal class counts). Scores will be given in the second equitation o/f of their respective divisions. First place trophy and ribbons to 12th place. Entry fee \$25

Pro/Am/Jr. Jumper Challenge- Sun. June 20th

Fences 1.0 m.

Open to all riders. This class will be run Table III, over a course of 10-12 jumps. There will be a mandatory change of rider one time during the course. Faults will be converted to time. Fastest time wins!

Entry fee \$25: All entry fees donated to The Rocky Mountain Horse Rescue

Hunter Pairs- Sat. June 19

Fences 2'3"-2'6"

To be shown over a course of at least 7 fences. One mandatory change of lead horse. Last jump on course to be jumped side by side. **Entry \$25/horse: All entries to be donated to Rocky Mtn. Horse Rescue.**

Ride and Run Competition – Sat. June 19 and June 26

To be show over a course of 8 jumps. First 5 jumps to be jumped by horse and rider. At a designated spot the rider dismounts and jumps the remaining 3 (lower) jumps on foot. Faults converted! Fastest time wins!! **All entries donated to the Claire Davis Fund. Entry fee \$25**

Five Bar Competition- Saturday June 26

This will be a fun class held during 'Cross the Meadow Farm II. The fence height will start at .75m and increase in height with each clear round. Riders may opt out of jumping any height and start at the height they chose. **Entry fee \$25. All entry fees donated to Claire Davis Fund**

Polish up those boots, oil those hooves, and show us your best equitation fashion! This award will be announced at the end of each equitation day at CTM I and CTM II.

The Best Dressed Jumper

To be awarded to the jumper entry with the best turnout, judged on both the horse and rider. The winner will be determined by the jumper judge out of all jumper entries and will receive a \$50 gift certificate to Betsy Hook Embroidery. Bring out your best matchy matchy, polish those boots, and show us your best jumper fashion! This award will be announced at the end of each jumper day at CTM I and CTM II.

The Jumper Style Award

To be awarded to the jumper entry with the most consistent and classic riding style. To be judged as an equitation round, no entry required. All jumper rounds will be evaluated for this award and announced at the end of the day. The Winner will receive a \$50 gift certificate to Betsy Hook Embroidery.
