SHOW RULES

1. All checks should be made payable to: GOLD CREST.
2. No refunds will be given unless accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate.
3. Stalls will be available for a fee of \$40.00 per night. The stalls will not be bedded. Jenny 303.875.6184.
4. Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A \$50.00 NSF fee will be charged.
5. Non-showing horses must pay an office fee, EMT fee and a grounds fee.

REGULATIONS

1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
2. No-judges will be allowed as long as time permits.
3. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on show grounds.
4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 - 7:50 am. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class[es] should it be in the best interest of the show.
6. Only one horse per entry form.
7. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
8. Each class will award a first place trophy and ribbons through sixth place.
9. Champion and Reserve will be offered for all divisions.
10. Pets must be on a leash at all times!

Judging: Each competitor receives a score with 3 components up to a maximum of 116:

1. Hunter score (out of 100) - The class is judged as a handy hunter class with a score
2. Performance bonus (up to 6 bonus points) - Two bonus points awarded for each high performance option taken on course (e.g., higher jump, natural jumps, more challenging line options), at least three options will be offered on course.
3. Handy bonus (up to 10 bonus points) - Zero to ten additional bonus points awarded at the judge's discretion for additional handiness and high performance displayed on course, including: Unique turns and approaches, inside turns, athleticism and boldness impressionable start and finish.

Open to all horses and ponies. Entries must have competed in at least one other class at this show. Formal attire is required. Prize money divided to the top 8 \$300, \$220, \$150, \$100, \$70, \$60, \$50, \$50. Ribbons through 8th place.

\$500 DOVER Gambler's Choice 2'3" - 3'6" Presented by Dover Saddlery

Class 103 - Entry Fee: \$45

In this competition, each obstacle carries a value from 10 points to 120 points depending upon difficulty. Obstacles will be built so that they may be jumped in both directions. After the starting tone, the competitor must cross the start line in either direction to start their time. They must then jump the obstacles, in either direction, a maximum of three times each, with the goal being to accumulate the highest point total. Disobediences are not penalized except for time taken. If an obstacle is knocked down, no points will be awarded. If an obstacle is jumped after being knocked down, no points will be awarded. If an obstacle is jumped a fourth time, no points will be awarded. When the 60 seconds has expired, a tone will sound and the competitor must cross the finish line to stop their time. At the conclusion of the round, and after their score has been announced, a tone will sound again and the competitor will have 30 seconds to attempt the Joker Jump. If jumped successfully, an additional 200 points will be added to their score. If a disobedience or knockdown occurs on the first attempt, 200 points will be deducted from their score. Only one attempt is allowed. The winner will be the

competitor who has the highest point total in the fastest time. Fences 2'3" to 3'6" (Joker jump may be higher). Open to all horses and ponies. Entries must have competed in at least one other class at this show. Prize money divided to the top 6 \$150, \$110, \$75, \$65, \$60, \$50. Ribbons through 8th place.

TIP Gambler's Choice 2'3" - 3'6" Presented by HORSE D'OEUVRES and The Jockey Club

Class 202 - Entry Fee: \$30

In this competition, each obstacle carries a value from 10 points to 120 points depending upon difficulty. Obstacles will be built so that they may be jumped in both directions. After the starting tone, the competitor must cross the start line in either direction to start their time. They must then jump the obstacles, in either direction, a maximum of three times each, with the goal being to accumulate the highest point total. Disobediences are not penalized except for time taken. If an obstacle is knocked down, no points will be awarded. If an obstacle is jumped after being knocked down, no points will be awarded. If an obstacle is jumped a fourth time, no points will be awarded. When the 60 seconds has expired, a tone will sound and the competitor must cross the finish line to stop their time. At the conclusion of the round, and after their score has been announced, a tone will sound again and the competitor will have 30 seconds to attempt the Joker Jump. If jumped successfully, an additional 200 points will be added to their score. If a disobedience or knockdown occurs on the first attempt, 200 points will be deducted from their score. Only one attempt is allowed. The winner will be the competitor who has the highest point total in the fastest time. Fences 2'3" to 3'6" (Joker jump may be higher). Open to all Thoroughbred Incentive Program enrolled Thoroughbreds. Entries must have competed in at least one other class at this show. Ribbons through 6th place, and trophy for first. This class will run concurrently with class # 103. Please be clear with your in-gate starter if you are to be judged on the TIP card AND the LEqMC Gambler's Choice card, or exclusively the TIP card!

Formal attire required. Ribbons 1st – 6th. Prize money divided to the top 8 \$90, \$66, \$45, \$30, \$21, \$18, \$15, \$15.


