SHOW RULES

1. All checks should be made payable to: GOLD CREST.
2. No refunds will be given unless accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate.
3. Stalls will be available for a fee of \$65.00 per day, or \$170 for the weekend. Four bags of shavings are required per stall. Text Jasmine for stall and bedding orders at 970.691.6122.
4. Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A \$50.00 NSF fee will be charged.
5. Non-showing horses must pay an office fee, EMT fee and a grounds fee.

REGULATIONS

1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
2. No-judges will be allowed as long as time permits.
3. Hard hats and boots with a heel must be worn at all times by all riders while on show grounds.
4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 - 7:50 am. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class[es] should it be in the best interest of the show.
6. Only one horse per entry form.
7. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
8. Each class will award a first place trophy and ribbons through sixth place.
9. Champion and Reserve will be offered for all divisions.
10. Pets must be on a leash at all times!



The Hunt and Go format will consist of two (2) phases, one (1) Classic Hunter and one (1) Handy Hunter. The phases will be jumped consecutively. All participants will complete both the Classic and the Handy portions even if penalties (rails, refusals, etc.) are incurred. Major penalties (falls, 3 refusals, off course, etc.) will result in elimination.

Formal attire required. Prize money divided to the top 6 \$150, \$110, \$75, \$65, \$55, \$45. Ribbons through 8th place. If fewer than 8 horses enter, management reserves the right to lower the entry fee and payouts accordingly.

\$1,000 Front Range Equine Performance Hunt and Go Derby

3' with high options at 3'5"

Class 202. Entry Fee: \$70

The Hunt and Go format will consist of two (2) phases, one (1) Classic Hunter and one (1) Handy Hunter. The phases will be jumped consecutively. All participants will complete both the Classic and the Handy portions even if penalties (rails, refusals, etc.) are incurred. Major penalties (falls, 3 refusals, off course, etc.) will result in elimination.

Formal attire required. Prize money divided to the top 8 \$300, \$220, \$150, \$100, \$70, \$60, \$50, \$50. Ribbons through 8th place. If fewer than 8 horses enter, management reserves the right to lower the entry fee and payouts accordingly.

\$250 Stirrup Derby

Class 203. Entry Fee: \$42

This performance hunter class presents competitors an opportunity to best showcase the talents of horse and rider over a challenging course. The class combines a Hunter Classic with a Handy Hunter class in a one round format.

Formal attire required. Prize money divided to the top 6 \$75, \$60, \$40, \$30, \$25, \$20. Ribbons through 8th place. If fewer than 8 horses enter, management reserves the right to lower the entry fee and payouts accordingly.

\$500 Gold Crest Fine Tack Gambler's Choice

Class 301 - Entry Fee: \$47

Open to all horses and ponies who have competed in at least one other non-prize money class at this show. In this competition, each obstacle carries a value from 10 points to 120 points depending upon difficulty. Obstacles will be built so that they may be jumped in both directions. After the starting tone, the competitor must cross the start line in either direction to start their time. They must then jump the obstacles, in either direction, a maximum of three times each, with the goal being to accumulate the highest point total. Disobediences are not penalized except for time taken. If an obstacle is knocked down, no points will be awarded. If an obstacle is jumped after being knocked down, no points will be awarded. If an obstacle is jumped a fourth time, no points will be awarded. When the 60 seconds has expired, a tone will sound and the competitor must cross the finish line to stop their time. At the conclusion of the round, and after their score has been announced, a tone will sound again and the competitor will have 30 seconds to attempt the Joker Jump. If jumped successfully, an additional 200 points will be added to their score. If a disobedience or knockdown occurs on the first attempt, 200 points will be deducted from their score. Only one attempt is allowed. The winner will be the competitor who has the highest point total in the fastest time. Fences 2'3" to 3'6" (Joker jump may be higher). Open to all horses and ponies. Entries must have competed in at least one other class at this show. Prize money divided to the top 6: \$150, \$110, \$75, \$65, \$55, \$45. Ribbons through 8th place. If fewer than 8 horses enter, management reserves the right to lower the entry fee and payouts accordingly.

\$1,000 Littleton Equine Medical Center Mini Prix

Class 302 - Entry Fee: \$70

Open to all horses and ponies who have competed in at least one other non-prize money class at this show. Formal attire is required. Prize money divided to the top 8 \$300, \$220, \$150, \$100, \$70, \$60, \$50, \$50. Ribbons through 8th place. If fewer than 8 horses enter, management reserves the right to lower the entry fee and payouts accordingly.

\$150 Fouret Farms Hunter Under Saddle Derbies

400. *Entry fee \$39* Open to any horse and rider combination. To be eligible, horses must have shown or be entered in at least one other hunter class over fences or under saddle at the show (warm ups do not qualify), To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter, both directions of the ring. Entries may be asked to hand gallop, but never more than 8 at a time. Entries will be brought to the middle until only the winner remains on the rail. Prize money to the top 3. \$100, \$30, \$20. Trophy for the winner.

401. *Entry fee \$39* Open to any stirrup rider. To be eligible, horses must have shown or be entered to show in at least one other hunter class over fences or under saddle at the show (warm ups do not qualify), To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter, both directions of the ring. Entries will be brought to the middle until only the winner remains on the rail. Prize money to the top 3. \$100, \$30, \$20. Trophy for the winner. Management reserves the right to split this class if entries warrant, if there is a minimum of 6 horses to fill each section.

\$150 The Grey Tail Modified Children's Hunter Under Saddle Derby

403. *Entry fee \$39* Open to horse and rider combinations that compete in the Modified Childrens division. To be eligible, horses must have shown or be entered in at least one other hunter class over fences or under saddle in the Modified Children's division (warm ups do not qualify). To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter, both directions of the ring. Entries will be brought to the middle until only the winner remains on the rail. Prize money to the top 3. \$100, \$30, \$20. Special prize for the winner.

SPECIAL CLASS PAYOUTS: IN THE EVENT THAT ENTRIES ARE LOWER THAN 8, THE CLASS ENTRY FEE WILL BE REDUCED AND PAYOUT WILL BE HALF OF WHAT IS POSTED IN PRIZE LIST. IN THE EVENT THAT 4 OR FEWER HORSES ARE ENTERED, THE CLASS FEE WILL BE REDUCED TO A STANDARD CLASS FEE AND NO PAYOUT WILL BE GIVEN.




