## **FRIDAY SCHOOLING:**

**Move-in begins at 12:00 am, Friday . Ticketed Schooling will be available from 1:00 pm until 5:00 pm on Friday. Schooling spots must be reserved in advance by the trainer .**

There must be a minimum of 15 horses signed up by the deadline or Friday schooling will be canceled. Notice of cancellation will be sent to those who have reservations. Schooling reservations must be in writing by email or text. **No phone reservations.** The names of the riders/ horses must be provided on schooling day. Sessions will cost \$35.00 per horse. Time of sessions will be determined by the number of horses waiting.

## **REGULATIONS:**

1. Back-to-back rounds are allowed and encouraged.
2. "No-judge" rides will be allowed if time permits and at management discretion.
3. ASTM certified helmets must be worn at all times by all riders while on the show grounds.
4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 am until thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the ring. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class should it be in the best interest of the show.
6. Only one (1) horse per entry form.
7. A one (1) minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
8. Pets must be on a leash at all times! \$100 fine paid by owner/exhibitor for any loose pets caught by management or facility staff.
9. Warmups will be Blue/Red and may be entered multiple times if time permits. Hunter Blue Ribbons are awarded for a score of eighty (80) or higher; Red ribbons for a score of seventy-two (72) to seventy-nine (79). Jumper Warmups are awarded a Blue Ribbon for a clear round.

## **ENTRY PROCEDURES:**

Entries must be received by 5:00 pm Monday, September 18, 2023, to avoid the Post Entry Fee. After picking up your number you are financially responsible for your entries. No extra charges will be assessed for adding classes as long as you add them prior to riding in the class. **Second rounds of Classics may not be scratched after the first round has been ridden.**

Cash or checks made out to CHJA. **NO CREDIT CARDS OR VENMO are accepted at this show.**

Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. **A \$50.00 NSF fee will be charged.**

Non-showing horses must pay an office fee, EMT fee, and a grounds fee. No day of show entries accepted.

From Santa Fe Drive turn west on Kelley Avenue, Cross two sets of railroad tracks and barn will be on the left. Kelley Avenue is 2.4 miles south of Titan Road. Watch for the “Louviers” sign. (303-519-2538 for more detailed directions if needed). *Make sure to use the zip code when Mapquesting.*

If train tracks are occupied, go south to Airport Road, turn west and then take the first right (north) on Lavaun Drive, and follow any branch back to Kelley Avenue, turn left and proceed west to Fox Hill.

## **Biosecurity Requirements at Fox Hill**

- A current negative Coggins test.
- ALL DOCUMENTATION MUST BE IN THE HORSE’S SHOW NAME. You will need to present documentation to pick up your numbers.  
Be prepared to show documentation at any time during the show.

## CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

**Hunter and Equitation Classics** The Hunter and Equitation Classics will be a two (2)- round format. Each round is scored and awarded placings 1st - 6th. Ribbons, a prize for 1<sup>st</sup> place and year-end points are given for each round. The scores for each round are then added together, and the overall winners are determined by the total scores. The overall Classic winners will receive ribbons and a prize for 1st place.

Hunter Classic winners will receive prize money for 1<sup>st</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> places: \$100.00 - \$50.00 - \$25.00 - \$15.00 - \$10.00.

Equitation Classic winners will receive prizes for placings 1st -5th.

Bonus year-end points for the overall Classics are awarded through 12<sup>th</sup> place: 1<sup>st</sup> place 20 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> place 16 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> place 14 points; 4<sup>th</sup> place 12 points; 5<sup>th</sup> place 10 points; 6<sup>th</sup> place 8 points; 7<sup>th</sup> place 6 points; 8<sup>th</sup> place 5 points; 9<sup>th</sup> place 4 points; 10<sup>th</sup> place 3 points; 11<sup>th</sup> place 2 points; and 12<sup>th</sup> place 1 point.

**Jumper Divisions and Stake Classes** Jumper Divisions will be a three (3) round format, with the third round offered as a \$200.00 stake class. Each round will be awarded placings 1st - 6th, with year-end points given through 6th place. A prize will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> place.

The stake classes will receive ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup>- 6th place, and a prize for first place. Prize money will be distributed for 1st -5th places: \$100.00 - \$50.00 - \$25.00 - \$15.00 - \$10.00.

Stake Class winners will receive bonus year-end points through 12th place: 1st place 20 points; 2nd place 16 points; 3rd place 14 points; 4th place 12 points, 5th place 10 points; 6th place 8 points; 7th place 6 points; 8th place 5 points; 9th place 4 points; 10th place 3 points; 11th place 2 points; and 12th place 1 point.

Champion and Reserve Champion Prizes and Bonus Points will also be given in the Jumper Division.

**Medal Classes** will receive ribbons for 1st-6th place as well as applicable medal points, a CHJA Medal and a prize for 1st place.

**Please note: There must be a minimum of five (5) horses competing in each Classic or Stake for prize money to be awarded.**
