## **DIRECTIONS:** The Colorado Horse Park

- From I-25 North Take Lincoln Avenue Exit, go East to Parker Road, go south to Bayou Gulch Road Turn left and follow to HP entrance on your left.
- From I-25 South Take Castle Pines Parkway Exit, go east to Parker Road. go south to Bayou Gulch Road. Turn left and follow to the CHP entrance on your left.

Stalls will be available for a fee of \$40.00 per day. The stalls will not be bedded. Bedding will be available for purchase. CHP requires a minimum of four (4) bags of shavings per stall purchased from CHP. Outside shavings are NOT allowed. Horses in stalls with no shavings will be charged a \$25.00 Cleaning Fee.

## **REGULATIONS:**

- 1. Back to back rounds are allowed and encouraged.
- 2. "No-judge" rides will be allowed if time permits and at management discretion.
- 3. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on Colorado Horse Park property.
- 4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 am until thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the ring. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
- 5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class should it be in the best interest of the show.
- 6. Only one (1) horse per entry form.
- 7. A one (1) minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
- 8. Pets must be on a leash at all times! \$100 fine paid by owner/exhibitor for any loose pets caught by management or facility staff.
- 9. Warm Ups will be Blue/Red and may be entered multiple times if time permits. Hunter Blue Ribbons are awarded for a score of eighty (80) or higher; Red ribbons for a score of seventy-two (72) to seventy (79). Jumper Warm Ups are awarded a Blue Ribbon for a clear round.

#### **ENTRY PROCEDURES:**

Entries must be received by 5:00 pm Wednesday, September 16, 2020 to avoid the Post Entry Fee. After picking up your number you are financially responsible for your entries. No extra charge for adding classes as long as you add them prior to riding in the class. **Second rounds of Classics may not be scratched after the first round has been ridden.** 

- Checks made out to CHJA.
- Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A \$50.00
   NSF fee will be charged.
- Non-showing horses must pay an office fee, EMT fee and a grounds fee.

# **COVID Procedures - MUST READ and FOLLOW!**

In order to continue to horse show in Colorado, we are trusting you to follow the below procedures in order to keep yourself and others at a minimized risk.

- All entries are to be made electronically through horseshowing.com or emailed to\_coshowentries@gmail.com. No paper entries will be accepted at the horse show office.
- Please take your temperature in the morning and scratch your entry if you have a fever. Do not come if you have COVID-19 symptoms or if you have been exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19. If you show symptoms during the horse show, please leave the grounds and notify the show manager IMMEDIATELY.
- Everyone should be mindful of space and keep a minimum of 6 feet away from any other person.
- Masks must be worn anywhere on the show grounds. Masks are not required to be worn by mounted riders.
- Trainer packets are to be picked up in the office by one representative and will only be handed out when all entries have a check attached. (Trainer may leave a barn check and will be responsible for any open accounts.)
- Rotations will be set up with the gate person on a first come first served basis. If you miss your rotation, or do not sign up for one, you will ride at the end of the division.
- The gate person has complete authority of the arena entrance and will manage the entrance to limit numbers.
- Only essential people may accompany horses to the warm-up area and back gate. This
  could include the trainer, a groom and one family member if the rider is a junior. All
  others should go directly from the trailer parking area to the viewing area at the show
  ring to watch their family member or barn mate compete. Please maintain responsible
  social distancing in the viewing areas! THIS INCLUDES MASKS.
- Due to COVID-19, show hospitality will be greatly limited this year. Complimentary water bottles will be available at certain locations, but you should plan to bring your own as paper cups and water dispensers will not be available at the backgate.
- No outside spectators allowed. Only competitors, parents and trainers, please. All ringside watching should be done as spaced out as possible.

## FRIDAY SCHOOLING AVAILABLE:

Ticketed Schooling will be available from Noon until 6:00 pm on Friday. Schooling spots must be reserved in advance by the trainer before noon Thursday. All spots reserved will be charged to the trainer and are non-refundable. Trainers may split these to their riders if done so in the show office before 10:00 am Saturday. Even if the trainer does not come to the show these charges will be billed and must be paid. There must be a minimum of 25 horses signed up by the deadline or Friday schooling will be

canceled. Notice of cancelation will appear on chja.org . Schooling reservations must be in writing by email or text.\* **No phone reservations**. The names of the riders/horses must be included for billing purposes. Sessions will cost \$20.00 per horse. Time of sessions will be determined by

the number of horses waiting.

## **CLASS SPECIFICATIONS:**

For specific class specifications, see the CHJA Rulebook. The Rulebook is available online at www.chja.org. **Hunter and Equitation Classics - Entry Fee - \$25.00/round:** The \$200.00 Hunter and Equitation

Classics will be a two (2)- round format. Each round is scored and awarded placings 1st - 6th.

Ribbons, a prize for 1st -place and year-end points are given for each round. The scores for each round are then added together, and the overall winners are determined by the total scores. The overall Classic winners will receive special ribbons and a prize for 1st place.

- Hunter Classic\* winners will receive prize money for 1<sup>st</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> places: \$100.00 \$50.00 \$25.00 \$15.00 \$10.00.
- Equitation Classic winners will receive prizes for placings 1st -6th.
- Bonus year-end points for the overall Classics are awarded through 12<sup>th</sup> place: 1<sup>st</sup> place 20 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> place 16 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> place 14 points; 4<sup>th</sup> place 12 points; 5<sup>th</sup> place 10 points; 6<sup>th</sup> place 8 points; 7<sup>th</sup> place 6 points; 8<sup>th</sup> place 5 points; 9<sup>th</sup> place 4 points; 10<sup>th</sup> place 3 points; 11<sup>th</sup> place 2 points; and 12<sup>th</sup> place 1 point.

Jumper Divisions and Stake Classes - Entry Fee - \$20.00/regular class; \$25.00/stake class: Jumper Divisions will be a three (3) round format, with the third round offered as a \$200.00 stake class. Each round will be awarded placings 1st - 6th, with year-end points given through 6thf place. A prize will be awarded for 1st place.

- The stake class\* will receive special ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup>places, and a prize for first place. Prize money will be distributed for 1st -5th places: \$100.00 \$50.00 \$25.00 \$15.00 \$10.00.
- Stake Class winners will receive bonus year-end points through 12th place: 1<sup>st</sup> place 20 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> place 16 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> place 14 points; 4<sup>th</sup> place 12 point,; 5<sup>th</sup> place 10 points; 6<sup>th</sup> place 8 points; 7<sup>th</sup> place 6 points; 8<sup>th</sup> place 5 points; 9<sup>th</sup> place 4 points; 10<sup>th</sup> place 3 points; 11<sup>th</sup> place 2 points; and 12<sup>th</sup> place 1 point.
- Champion and Reserve Champion Prizes and Bonus Points will also be given in the Jumper Division.

\*Please note: There must be a minimum of five (5) horses competing in each Classic or Stake for prize money to be awarded.

**Medal Classes** will receive ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>place as well as applicable medal points, a CHJA Medal and a prize for 1st place.

\$200 Owen O'Meara Memorial Pro/Jr-Am Derby (2'9" OR 3') - Entry Fee - \$25.00: To qualify, horses must have competed in at least one (1) of the hunter over-fences classes. This is a two (2) round class. One (1) round must be ridden by a professional, and the other must be ridden by a junior or amateur. The first round will be a classic hunter round to be shown over a minimum of eight (8) jumps. The second round will be a handy hunter style course. Either rider may ride either course, but the switch of riders after the first round must take place in a designated 'change box' inside the arena. One (1) groom may assist in the rider switch, with a change of saddle is permitted. The switch must not exceed sixty (60) seconds, and there may be NO communication between riders. The switch will be monitored by an official timekeeper.

After sixty (60) seconds, one (1) full point per second over the time allowed will be deducted from the overall score. Each round will receive a numerical score, and the total combined score will be used to determine placings. Two (2) separate derbies will be offered based on the height of the jumps - one (1) derby with jumps set at 2'9'' and a separate derby with jumps set at 3'. The same horse/rider combination may only compete in ONE (1) derby that is applicable to the jump height of the hunter classes they competed in. Winners will receive prize money for  $1^{st}$  -  $5^{th}$  places: \$100.00 - \$50.00 - \$25.00 - \$15.00 - \$10.00.

VHM/MQC Professional's Equitation Challenge - Entry Fee - \$0: Open to professionals only. This is a two (2) round class. The first round will be ridden over an equitation/medal style course of at least eight (8) jumps. Riders will be judged on riding style, technique, and accuracy. Riders will come back to compete in either a test over jumps or in an equitation on the flat (utilizing USEF tests 1-16) based on the judge's discretion. Jumps will be set at 2'9". Winner will receive a gift basket and ribbons awarded through 6th place. Sponsored by VHM Woodworking and McCombie's Quarantine Cuts.

## **BIOSECURITY AT THE COLORADO HORSE PARK:**

- A current negative Coggins test
- Vaccination records showing date of vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 (booster must be within 180 days)
- Health certificate dated by a licensed veterinarian within 10 days of arriving at the venue\*\* WNV, EEE, WEE, Tetanus and Rabies are strongly recommended.
- Horses may not unload until paperwork is approved. All horses must enter the facility off Bayou Gulch Road. There will only be one entrance open and it will be the first entry east of Ponderosa School and across from the church. No entrance for horse show trailers through the top gate on South Pinery Dr.
- ALL DOCUMENTATION MUST BE IN THE HORSE'S SHOW NAME! This can be sent with entries to <a href="mailto:coshowentries@gmail.com">coshowentries@gmail.com</a>. Please bring copies with you to the show.
