Know Before You Show:

Veterinary / Health Requirements for all horses/ponies on grounds:

- Must have a health certificate dated within 30 days, regardless of if the horse is showing. Watch the FW Facebook page as this may change to within 10 days if there are any local health concerns.
- Must have proof of negative coggins in the horse's show name

If you are considering competing at the USEF Regional show on Sunday, July 12th, you will need to submit a separate entry with the following additional requirements:

USEF Regional Requirements:

- Proof of vaccination, including a booster for EHV-1 and EHV-4 within the last 180 days
- All trainers, riders, and owners of record must be active members of USEF or pay the Show Pass fee. We cannot process memberships or show passes on site, per USEF.
- All trainers, riders, and owners of record must have completed SafeSport training. You cannot participate in the show (i.e. we cannot issue a back number) until it is complete. It must be done online.
- Horses must have a USEF Recording number or USHJA Registration number. Their membership must be active for points to count.

Rules and Regulations

CLASSES Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current CHJA rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

ACCIDENT & THEFT Every animal is under the supervision of show officials for the duration of the show. Management reserves the right to make decisions about any entry. Nonetheless, CHJA, its board of directors, and the Four Winds, its owners, officials, and employees are in no way responsible for any loss or accident which may occur. It is a condition of entry that each exhibitor holds the Four Winds and CHJA harmless for any damage that may occur to any person, animal, or property.

ACCIDENT & THEFT The Four Winds, the owner, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show.

SCHEDULE CHANGES Management reserves the right to combine or cancel any classes deemed necessary and the right to refuse any entry. All decisions to combine, divide, or cancel classes or divisions will be made in accordance with CHJA rules.

FENCES The spread of a fence may not exceed its height.

HELMETS All riders must wear ASTM 2022 or newer Certified protective headgear while mounted.

NO SMOKING is permitted inside the barns

DOGS must be leashed at all times. Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Owners who do not have their dogs leashed may be fined \$50 per occurrence.

General Information

CONDUCT Please remember that you are in front of the general public and children and should set a good example of horsemanship and sportsmanship at all times. Management reserves the right to remove anyone from grounds that is behaving in an unsportsmanlike manner. Physical or verbal abuse of any person or animal on the showgrounds will not be tolerated.

Consider your horse's long term future and well being when reviewing your class count.

SCHOOLING is available on Friday before 5pm with a separate, signed liability waiver. There is no EMT on Fridays. Schooling is also available from 6:45-7:45 on Sat morning.

AWARDS Ribbons are awarded for 1st through 6th place. There is a prize for 1st place. Champion and Reserve Champion are awarded in divisions with 3 or more classes with 3 or more entries. There is a prize for Champion.

STABLING Event stalls are 10x10 wood box stalls, with wooden framed half doors and compacted dirt flooring. Stall fees include 2 bags of shavings. Additional bags can be purchased at \$10 / bag. Please treat the space with respect and do not permanently alter the stalls. Do not steal clips used to secure the stall doors.

SHARPS DISPOSAL Containers for sharps are located at the event stalls and at the indoor arena cross-ties.

ARENAS The East hunter/equitation arena is 200' x 275'. East schooling arena is 70' x 160'. The West jumper arena is 130' x 240'. These arenas all have sand footing. The Indoor arena is 60' x 160' with AC Washed Sand, treated with a dust suppressant.

LUNGING is available in the schooling arenas (indoor and at the entrance of the East Arena) from 7am-8am. These arenas may be used for lunging additionally if there are no horses flatting.

VENDORS AND FOOD SERVICE La Campechana's Mexican Food Truck is in attendance from 10am-1pm. Equimotion Performance Bodywork/Therapeutic services will be present, as well as professional photographers A&B Photography.

Fees and Payments

ACCEPTED FORMS OF PAYMENT Checks and cash are preferred. Venmo, PayPal, and Credit Cards are accepted with a 3.25% processing fee. For any returned checks, there's a \$50 processing charge.

2. Health certificate dated by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of arrival

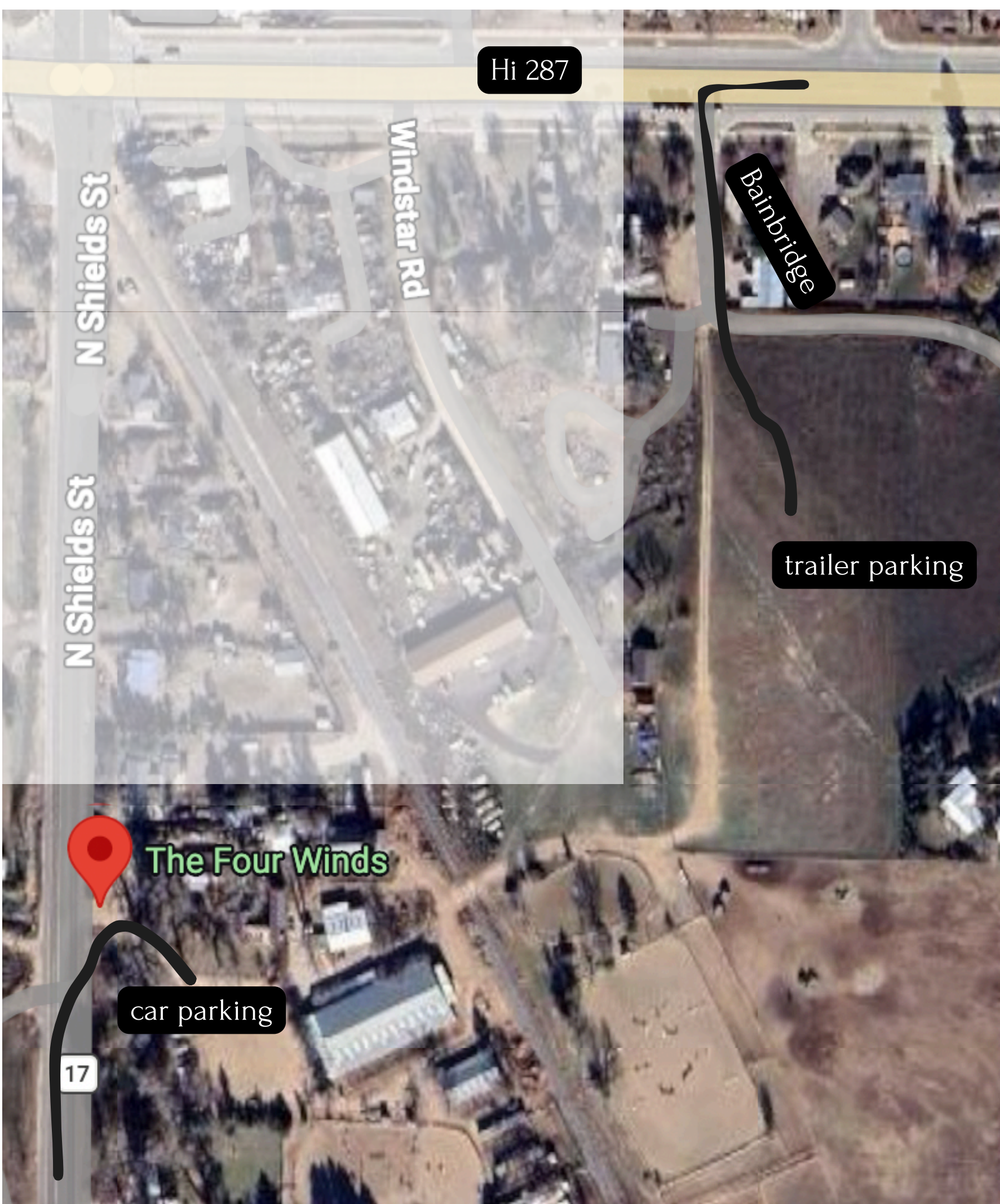

Directions

2504 N Shields St, Fort Collins CO 80524



From I-25, take exit 269B West for Mulberry Road (sign says for Fort Collins).

After a few miles, turn right onto Highway 287 / College Ave. 287 will curve into an east-west street.

Just past Jax Farm and Ranch, turn left at Bainbridge Rd (two blocks short of the light at Shields). Pull in straight into the pasture for trailer parking.

Cars can continue to the light at Shields, take a left, and turn into our main entrance just two blocks after the light.

Warm Up Class Specs

Warm Ups are Blue/Red Ribbon rounds and can be ridden multiple times before the rider's other classes. Blue ribbons are awarded for a score of 78 or higher, red ribbons for scores between 72 and 77. For Clear Round Warm Ups, jumpers are awarded a blue ribbon for a clear round within the time allowed. Class fees: \$35

Hunter & Equitation Class Specs

All hunter and equitation divisions require 3 to fill, and may be combined with other age groups at the same height. Modifieds and Lows may combine. For other rules regarding cross-entry, view the CHJA Rulebook. Class fees: \$35 / Division fees: \$105

\$200 Thoroughbred Hunt & Go Derby 2'3-2'6

This class is a hunt-and-go derby open to thoroughbreds only who have not shown at 3' or higher this year. Professionals are welcome. Competitors will show over ~7 fences for a traditional "hunter" round and then continue immediately on to the "handy" round with ~5 additional fences. Requires 5 entries for prize money. Prize money is divided across top three placings: 50% / 30% / 20%. Class fee: \$35

Jumper Class Specs

All Jumper divisions require 3 to fill, and generally may be combined with the next higher height, except .70m and .75m. View the CHJA Rulebook for more info. Class fees: \$35 / Division fees: \$105

.70m Outreach Jumper: optimum time, no oxers

.75m CHJA Jumper: optimum time, open to riders who have not shown above .90m

.85m – 1.15m Jumper: open to all riders

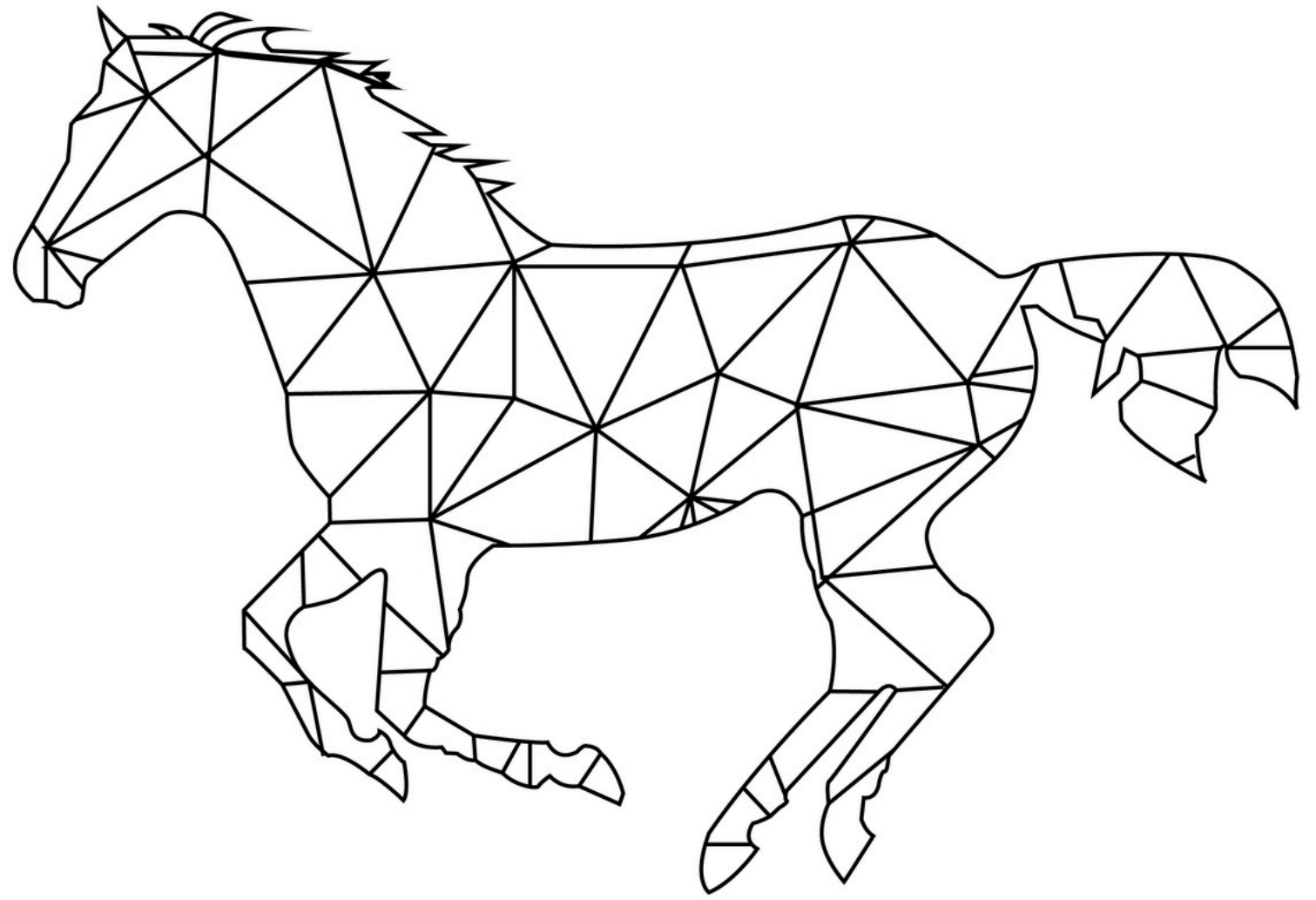
