Know Before You Show:

Veterinary / Health Requirements for all horses/ponies on grounds:

- Must have a recorded microchip
- Must have a health certificate dated within 30 days, regardless of if they're showing. Watch the FW Facebook page as this may change to within 10 days if there are any local health concerns
- Must have a vaccination record with vaccines given within the last 180 days but not within the last 7 days
- Must have proof of negative coggins in the horse's show name

Organization / Membership Requirements:

- All trainers, riders, and owners of record must be active members of USEF or pay the Show Pass fee. We cannot process memberships or show passes on site, per USEF.
- All trainers, riders, and owners of record must have completed SafeSport training. You cannot participate in the show (i.e. we cannot issue a back number) until it is complete. It must be done online.
- Horses must have a USEF Recording number and USHJA Registration number. Their membership must be active for points to count.
- Horses entered in Outreach classes will not be eligible for USEF points in those divisions.

If you compete at the Four Winds CHJA show on July 11th, you must submit a new entry and your health documentation again for this show.

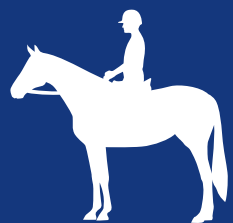

Rules and Regulations

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

SAFESPORT REMINDER All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. SCHEDULE CHANGES Management reserves the right to combine or cancel any classes deemed necessary and the right to refuse any entry in accordance with GR914. All decisions to combine, divide, or cancel classes or divisions will be made in accordance with USEF / USHJA rules.

ENTRIES Competitors are encouraged to use fourwinds.horsespot.net/shows to enter, but entries can also be submitted via email to jasmine@fourwinds.net. Scanned PDFs are preferred but clear photographs will be accepted. Entry blanks will ONLY be accepted when signed by the owner or trainer and rider. No back numbers will be released until all credentials and signatures are in order.

Per USEF, BACK NUMBERS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES THAT A HORSE IS OUT OF ITS STALL.

Rules and Regulations

NO SMOKING is permitted inside the barns.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

MEASUREMENTS All exhibitors in the Junior Hunter sections must present their measurement cards at the office before numbers will be released. All Juniors Hunters who do not possess a current measurement card will be measured with the steward by appointment. If a measurement is needed, please notify the horse show by emailing jasmine@fourwinds.net so that arrangements may be made with the steward.

Rules and Regulations

HELMETS All riders must wear ASTM 2022 or newer Certified protective headgear while mounted.

ACCIDENT & THEFT The Four Winds, the owner, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show.

DOGS must be leashed at all times. Per USEF Rule 1301.6 dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards. Owners who do not have their dogs leashed will be fined \$50 per occurrence.

CONDUCT Please remember that you are in front of the general public and children and should set a good example of horsemanship and sportsmanship at all times. Management reserves the right to remove anyone from grounds that is behaving in an unsportsmanlike manner. Physical or verbal abuse of any person or animal on the showgrounds will not be tolerated.

Consider your horse's long term future and well being when reviewing your class count.

FENCES The spread of a fence may not exceed its height.

CLASSES USEF GR902.1 EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

General Information

STABLING Event stalls are 10x10 wood box stalls, with wooden framed half doors and compacted dirt flooring. Stall fees include 2 bags of shavings. Additional bags can be purchased at \$10 / bag. Please treat the space with respect and do not permanently alter the stalls. Do not steal clips used to secure the stall doors.

SHARPS DISPOSAL Containers for sharps are located at the event stalls and at the indoor arena crossties.

ARENAS The East hunter/equitation arena is 200' x 275'. East schooling arena is 70' x 160'. The West jumper arena is 130' x 240'. These arenas all have sand footing. The Indoor arena is 60' x 160' with AC Washed Sand, treated with a dust suppressant.

LUNGING is available in the schooling arenas (indoor and at the entrance of the East Arena) from 7am-8am. These arenas may be used for lunging additionally if there are no horses flatting.

SCHOOLING is available on Saturday after the conclusion of the CHJA show, until 5pm. Horses can also school over fences from 6:30 to 7:30am on Sunday morning.

BACK NUMBERS must be worn and visible whenever a horse is out of its stall.

AWARDS Ribbons are awarded for 1st through 6th place. There is a prize for 1st place. Champion and Reserve Champion are awarded in divisions with 3 or more classes with 3 or more entries. There is a prize for Champion.

VENDORS AND FOOD SERVICE La Campechana's Mexican Food Truck is in attendance from 10am-1pm. Equimotion Performance Bodywork/Therapeutic services will be present, as well as professional photographers A&B Photography.

Fees and Payments

ACCEPTED FORMS OF PAYMENT Checks and cash are preferred. Venmo, PayPal, and Credit Cards are accepted with a 3.25% processing fee. For any returned checks, there's a \$50 processing charge.

LATE ENTRIES Entries submitted after Monday, July 6th are accepted with a \$25 late fee.

USEF FEES Each horse will be charged a USEF fee of \$25 (\$15 Drugs and Medication, \$10 USEF) and a \$5 fee for USHJA Zone fees. Any nonmember must purchase a \$45 show pass from USEF.org and a 4a30 show pass from USHJA.org. Show passes cannot be purchased from the horse show office. They may only be purchased for one show per year. The only exception to this is riders competing only in Outreach divisions: 2'9 Eq, 2'6 Eq, .70m, .75m-.80m Jumpers, .85m Jumpers, or Crossrails/Pile of Poles.

OPPORTUNITY / OUTREACH CLASSES All opportunity classes will be held in accordance with GR821. Riders who are entered in these classes only are exempt from Federation membership requirements and are not required to pay a non member fee but are required to list their membership numbers if the participant is a member.

2. Vaccination record showing date of vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 (booster must be within the last 180 days)
3. Health certificate dated by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of arrival

Warm Up Classes must be closed prior to start of each height medal, i.e. a rider may not show in a warm up class after the medals have started.

Warm Ups are Blue/Red Ribbon rounds and can be ridden multiple times before the rider's other classes. Blue ribbons are awarded for a score of 78 or higher, red ribbons for scores between 72 and 77. 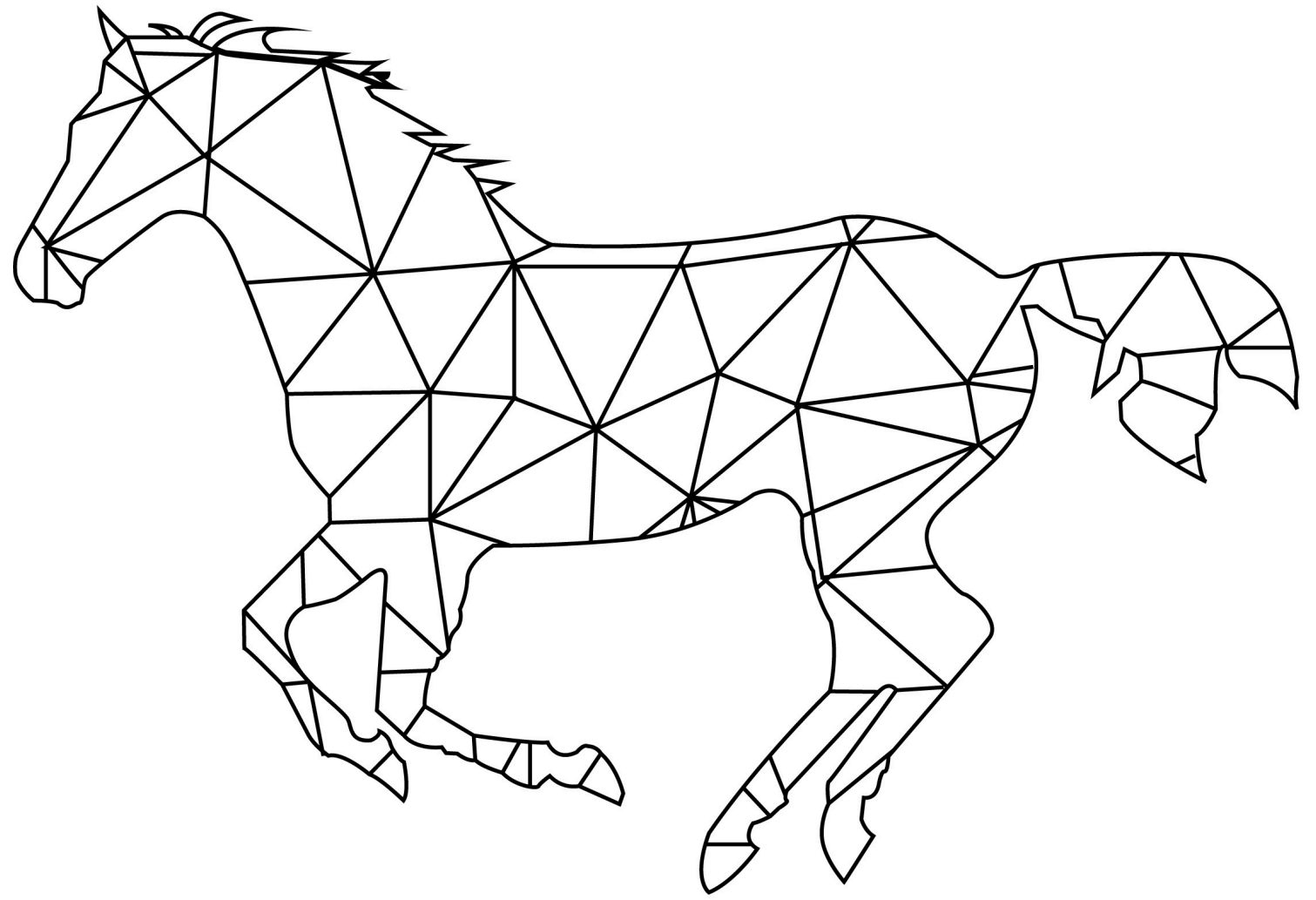

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of **Four Winds I Medals & Jumpers** (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR907.4.

If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber and competing only in classes that are exempt from membership requirements, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless and until USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my Fan account. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice.
