DIRECTIONS

From I-25 heading north, take exist 269B West, and you will be on Highway 14 / Mulberry. Go west a couple miles until Highway 287 / College and turn right. Now traveling north on College, head through town until the street curves towards the west. Just past Jax Farm and Ranch, at the railroad tracks, turn left onto Shields Street. Half a block south, a Four Winds sign marks the entrance on the east side of the road. Follow the driveway past the barn and train tracks for trailer parking.

For trailer parking, follow the same directions until you get to Jax Farm and Ranch. Instead of turning left on Shields, turn left onto Bainbridge Rd, which is a couple of blocks sooner. Follow the driveway straight and it will lead you to an open pasture used for trailer parking.

SCHOOLING

The arena is open for schooling as early as one hour before the scheduled start time, but cannot begin until an EMT is on the property. Hard hats and boots with a heel are required. Schooling is supervised and numbers may be limited. Dangerous riders will be excused from the ring.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES / BIOSECURITY

It is the Four Winds' policy to require a current health certificate and current coggins for **all** horses trailering onto the property. A current health certificate is considered to be within 90 days of the competition. If there is an outbreak of an infectious disease, however, these policies will change depending on the disease's incubation period. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Every class covered herein follows the rules and specifications of the current CHJA Rule Book and will be judged according to it.
- Every animal is under the supervision of the show officials for the duration of the show and the Four Winds reserves the right to make decisions regarding any entry. Nonetheless, CHJA, its Board of Directors, and the Four Winds are in no way responsible for any loss or accident which may occur. It is a condition of entry that each exhibitor holds the Four Winds and CHJA harmless for any damage that may occur to any person, animal, or property.
- Courses are posted at the rings one hour before the start of classes. A three-minute gate and dotted line can be enforced. Start time for each arena is posted on the show schedule.
- Classes can be cancelled, combined, or divided if, in the management's opinion, the entries warrant it.
- Exhibitors are permitted to bring and school horses which are not showing. Non-showing horses are free to fully use the facility as long as it does not conflict with the show. Stalls may be reserved prior. Non-showing horses will be charged a \$15 grounds fee.
- A prize for 1st place and six ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Champion and reserve champion are awarded to the winners of complete divisions. Champion and reserve will be awarded in the jumper classes when each division is completed on Sunday.
- Pets must be on a leash at all times.

FEES AND ENTRIES

- Classes are \$20 each.
- Medals are \$25, and classic fees vary based on prize money given away.
- EMT fee is \$15 per rider.
- Office fee is \$20 per horse.
- A \$15 Grounds fee is charged for each horse without a stall.
- Late fees of \$25 are applied to entries added on show day.
- Box stalls are available for a fee of \$35 per day or \$60 for the weekend. The grounds fee is waived for stalled horses. Stalls *are already* bedded with shavings. Please call Jasmine at (970) 691-6122 to reserve a stall prior to the show.
- In total, the average cost of competing at the Four Winds is about \$125, for a warmup and one division. We are one of the least expensive, CHJA-rated horse shows in Colorado!
- Any returned checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days.
- Late fees are nonrefundable, but as classes are cancelled or asked to be filled, the charge for entered classes may be dismissed. Show scratches are not refunded the stall fee if they were present at the show and stalled there.
- It is not necessary to be a member of CHJA in order to show at the Four Winds. To be considered for points and year end awards, however, you should be a member.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

- All rated divisions are run in accordance with the current CHJA rulebook, which should be referenced for any questions regarding fence height, restrictions on entry for riders and horses, as well as qualifications for medals.
- Outreach Classes are now a part of CHJA's program and eligible for year-end awards. For more information about these new classes, and about becoming an Outreach member, please visit <u>CHJA.org</u>
- Warm Up Classes: Any horse and rider combination is eligible to enter. These classes are held open and fence heights adjusted to each division. Warm up classes are not pinned like regular classes; instead, blue and red ribbons are awarded for high scores in the hunter arena, and a blue ribbon is awarded for a clear round within the time allowed in the jumper arena. Additional warm-ups may be ridden for an additional fee of \$20 each.
- \$250 Mini Prix: Horse and rider combination are required to have shown in at least 2 classes of jumpers to be eligible to enter. Entry fee is \$30. Fence heights will be set at 3', 3'3", 3'6", and 3'9" respective to riders' divisions. Management reserves the right to cancel the class with fewer than five entries.
- \$250 Jumper Relay: Horse and rider combination are required to have shown in at least 2 classes of jumpers to be eligible to enter. Entry fee is \$30. A team of two riders compete over a course where half the fences are set at 2'3" and the other half at 2'9". One rider completes the first half while holding a baton, which is then passed on to the second rider, who completes the second half of the course. All faults are converted to time, and the fastest time wins.
