The Four Winds Shows now offers two *Regional* competitions, recognized by USEF!

July 12th will feature national and CHJA medals, such as the ASPCA Maclay, Hamel, Ariat, and THIS medals, as well as Jumper divisions.

September 26th and 27th will feature a full competition with USHJA Outreach and USEF hunter divisions, Jr/Am and Open jumpers, and medals.

These shows have separate prize lists and entries. USEF memberships with SafeSport training, and Biosecurity documents, are requirements of competition. If you attend the CHJA show on July 11th and want to compete on the 12th, you *must* separately enter that show.

CHJA Show Fees

Classes, Medals, and Add-Backs: \$35 per class
Registration Fee: \$75 per entry
Late Fee: \$25 per late entry

We accept Credit Card and Venmo (with a 3.25% processing fee) and checks. There is a \$50 charge for all returned checks.



Outreach Show Fees

Outreach classes at a CHJA show follow CHJA fees

Classes: \$30 per class
Registration Fee: \$60 per entry

Non-Showing Horses

We encourage green horses to attend! Non-showing horses should register for the show and pay a registration fee. When riding, back numbers must be worn.

Entries close on Wednesdays the week of CHJA shows. After the closing date, entries will still be accepted with a \$25 late fee.

July's closing date for entries is **Monday, July 6th.**

There's no closing deadline for Outreach shows.

Biosecurity

A current health certificate and negative coggins test are required for all horses trailering onto the property. You can email these documents ahead of time to jasmine@fourwinds.net or upload them to HorseSpot with your entry.

A negative coggins is valid for one year. A current health certificate is within 30 days of the competition unless requested otherwise via our social media page. The Four Winds can change this policy at any time. “Valid” or “current” timeframes will change if an infectious disease is prevalent in the area. Stay updated via our [Facebook page](#) or [HorseSpot](#), but most importantly, please don't bring a horse who is sick to the show.

Stabling

\$80

Stalls are rented for the entire weekend. You are welcome to share a stall with multiple horses over the competition and we will split fees, but we cannot accommodate renting stalls by individual days.

All stalls *include* two bags of shavings. Additional bags are \$10 per bag.

Schooling

The arena is open for schooling one hour before the scheduled start time. No jumping is allowed until an EMT is present on the property.

Schooling is supervised and numbers in the arena may be limited. Dangerous riders will be excused from the arena.

Friday schooling is available with a stall at no additional cost. There will be no EMT on Fridays.

Directions

Trailers: From I-25, take exit 269B West for Fort Collins. You will be on Highway 14 / Mulberry. Go west a couple miles until you reach Hi 287 / College. Turn right onto College. Head through town until the street curves towards the west. Just past Jax Farm and Ranch, turn left onto **Bainbridge**. Go straight; you will be in a large open pasture where you can park.

Cars: Follow the same directions as above, but continue on Hi 287 until you reach a set of railroad tracks. Turn left onto Shields St. Half a block south, a Four Winds sign marks the entrance on the east (left) side of the road. Follow the driveway into our car parking lot.

Rules and Regulations

Anyone asked to leave the facility for not abiding by our rules will not receive a refund.

- Every class covered herein follows the rules and regulations of the current CHJA Rule Book and will be judged according to it.
- Every animal is under the supervision of show officials for the duration of the show. Management reserves the right to make decisions about any entry. Nonetheless, CHJA, its board of directors, and the Four Winds are in no way responsible for any loss or accident which may occur. It is a condition of entry that each exhibitor holds the Four Winds and CHJA harmless for any damage that may occur to any person, animal, or property.
- Boots with a heel and an ASTM certified helmet will be worn at all times while mounted on the facility.
- Pets must be on a leash at all times.
- Courses are posted at the rings one hour before the start of classes. Classes can be cancelled, combined, or divided if, in the management's opinion, the entries warrant it.



Class Descriptions

- All rated divisions are run in accordance with the current CHJA rulebook, which should be referenced for any questions regarding fence height, restrictions on entry for riders and horses, as well as medal qualifications.
- Riders are *not* required to be CHJA or USHJA members to compete at these shows. However, we encourage you to become a member in order to participate in CHJA's programs, clinics, and year-end awards. By becoming a *free* USHJA Outreach member, you are also eligible for some grants and nominations to National shows. Go to chja.org and <https://www.ushja.org/membership/joinrenew> to become members today.
- Championships: Champion and Reserve Champion are awarded in complete divisions. There is 1 jumper division at each height for the entire weekend. 1st through 6th ribbons are awarded in all classes, with 1st place receiving a prize.
- Warm Up classes: Any horse and rider combination is eligible to enter. These classes are held open and fence heights adjusted to each division. In the hunter arena, a blue ribbon is awarded for a score of 78 or higher, and a red ribbon for scores 72-77. In the jumper arena, a blue ribbon is awarded for a clear round within the time allowed. Additional warm ups may be ridden for an additional class fee each.
- Jumper Add-Backs: Horse and rider need to have shown in at least 1 other jumper class to be eligible for prize money. 30% of each class fee will be put into the pot. Pay out is: 50% / 30% / 20%

Special Classes Descriptions

July 11th

- \$200 Thoroughbred Hunt & Go 2'3-2'6: This class is a hunt-and-go derby open to thoroughbreds only who have not shown at 3' or higher this year. Professionals are welcome. Competitors will show over ~7 fences for a traditional “hunter” round and then continue immediately on to the “handy” round with ~5 additional fences. Minimum of 5 entries required for prize money. Prize money is divided across top three placings: 50% / 30% / 20%. Class fee: \$35

August 16th

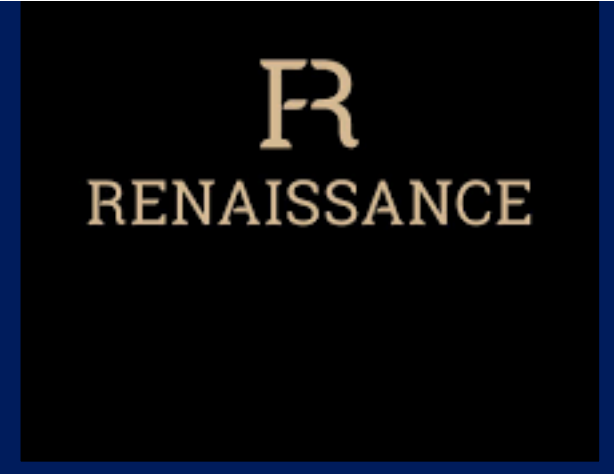
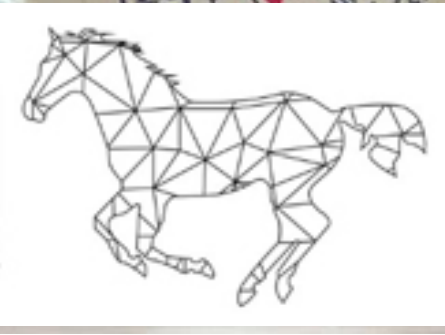
- \$300 Dans Handmade Saddle Soap Choose Your Own Equitation: Design and ride in your own equitation course! This class runs concurrently with the equitation at the 2'6-2'9 and 3' heights (Low and CHJA Eq divisions). Pay out is: 50% / 30% / 20%

November 1st

- \$100 Tallgrass Ventures Rotating Rider Equitation Flat: Open to jr/am riders showing at 2'6” or higher (Lows / .75m Jumpers are minimum qualifying height *for safety*). Riders must have competed in at least one other class. Riders compete in an equitation on the flat, and top 4 riders will be asked to dismount, rotate, and ride another competitor’s horse on the flat. Winner takes all!
