Fees

- Regular classes \$22 per class
- Medal classes \$25 per class
- EMT fee \$20 per rider
- Office fee \$20 per horse / entry
- Grounds fee \$15 per non-stabled horse
- Stabling \$50 per day
includes 2 bags of shavings
\$8 per additional bag of shavings
- Late fee \$25 for late entries

Outreach Fees

- Classes \$15 per class
- EMT Fee \$15 per rider
- Office Fee \$15 per horse / entry
- Grounds Fee \$10 per non-stabled horse
- Stabling \$50 per day
includes 2 bags of shavings
\$8 per bag of shavings

We encourage green horses to attend! Non-showing horses pay an EMT and Grounds fee.

There is a \$50 charge for all returned checks. Accounts have 10 days to be paid in full with certified funds.

Stabling

Stalls are \$50 per day. Overnight stalling is considered two days. Each day includes 2 bags of shavings. Additional bagged shavings are available at \$8 per bag.

You must contact Jasmine directly with stall requests. She can be reached at 970.691.6122. Please include how many bags of shavings you'd like.

You may rent stabling as a tack stall provided there is availability. Availability is limited, so call early!

Biosecurity

A current health certificate and negative coggins test are required for **all** horses trailering onto the property. You can email these documents to jasmine@fourwinds.net

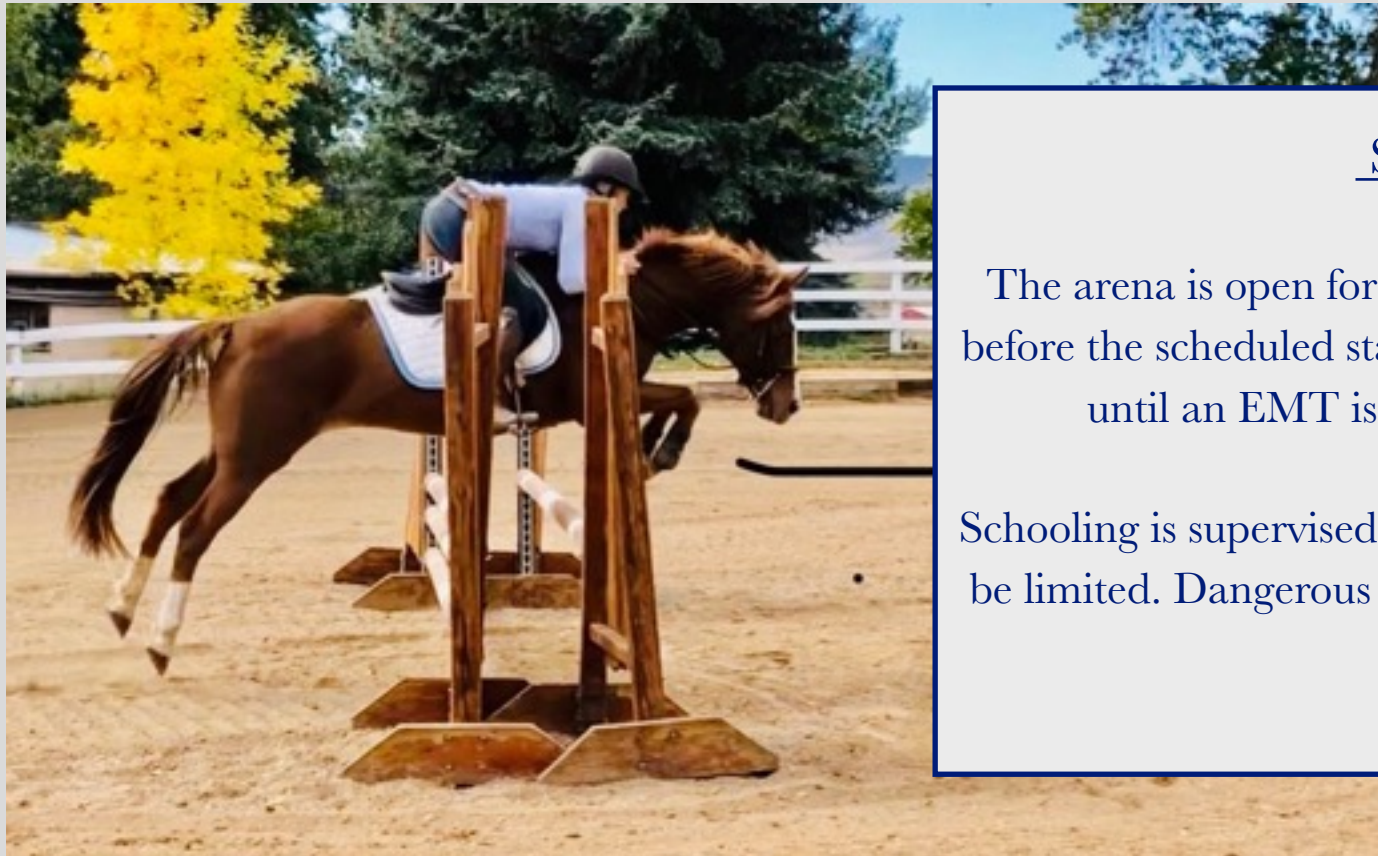
A negative coggins is valid for one year. A current health certificate is considered to be within 90 days of the competition. Please ensure that these documents are issued in your horse's show name / match the entry.

However, the Four Winds reserves the right to change this policy at any time. "Valid" or "current" timeframes will change depending on the prevalence of infectious diseases in the area. Stay updated via our Facebook page, where the most current and relevant information (as well as class counts!) will be communicated.

Directions

Trailers: From I-25 heading north, take exit 269B West for Fort Collins. You will be on Highway 14 / Mulberry. Go west a couple miles until you reach Hi 287 / College. Turn right onto College. Head through town until the street curves towards the west. Just past Jax Farm and Ranch, turn left onto **Bainbridge**. Go straight; you will be in a large open pasture where you can park.

Cars: Follow the same directions as above, but continue on Hi 287 until you reach a set of railroad tracks. Turn left onto Shields St. Half a block south, a Four Winds sign marks the entrance on the east (left) side of the road. Follow the driveway into our car parking lot.



Schooling

The arena is open for schooling as early as one hour before the scheduled start time. No jumping is allowed until an EMT is present on the property.

Schooling is supervised and numbers in the arena may be limited. Dangerous riders will be excused from the arena.



Rules and Regulations

Anyone asked to leave the facility for not abiding by the rules, including Covid policies, will not receive a refund.

- Every class covered herein follows the rules and regulations of the current CHJA Rule Book and will be judged according to it.
- Every animal is under the supervision of show officials for the duration of the show. Management reserves the right to make decisions about any entry. Nonetheless, CHJA, its board of directors, and the Four Winds are in no way responsible for any loss or accident which may occur. It is a condition of entry that each exhibitor holds the Four Winds and CHJA harmless for any damage that may occur to any person, animal, or property.
- Boots with a heel and an ASTM certified helmet will be worn at all times while mounted on the facility.
- Pets must be on a leash at all times.
- Courses are posted at the rings one hour before the start of classes. Classes can be cancelled, combined, or divided if, in the management's opinion, the entries warrant it.

Class Descriptions

- All rated divisions are run in accordance with the current CHJA rulebook, which should be referenced for any questions regarding fence height, restrictions on entry for riders and horses, as well as qualifications for medals.
- Outreach classes are now part of CHJA's program and eligible for year-end awards. Become an Outreach member by visiting CHJA.org or completing a membership form at the office.
- Warm Up classes: Any horse and rider combination is eligible to enter. These classes are held open and fence heights adjusted to each division. They are not pinned like regular classes; instead, blue and red ribbons are awarded for high scores in the hunter arena, and a blue ribbon is awarded for a clear round within the time allowed in the jumper ring. Additional warm ups may be ridden for an additional class fee of \$22 each.
- Jumper Stakes: Horse and rider need to have shown in at least 1 other jumper class to be eligible for prize money. Stake classes do not count towards division awards. Out of the \$22 entry fee, \$10 will be put into the pot. Pay out is as follows: 1st - 50%, 2nd - 30%, 3rd - 20%
- \$250 Mini Prix: Horse and rider combination need to have shown in at least 1 other jumper class to be eligible to enter. Entry fee is \$40. The Mini Prix will run concurrently (at the same time as) the rider's respective division (after the .75m Jumpers) and close at the end of the day. Management reserves the right to cancel the class or withdraw the prize money with fewer than five entries.
