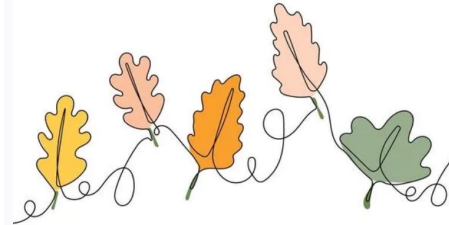
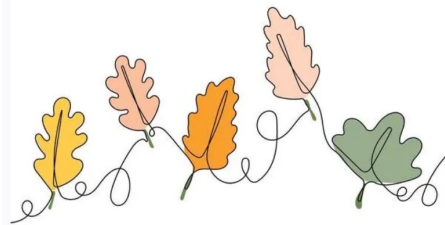

SHOW RULES

1. All checks should be made payable to: GOLD CREST.
2. Entries can be paid with cash, check or venmo.
3. No refunds will be given unless accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate.
4. Stalls and shavings will be available. **All stalls are required to have a five bag minimum per CHP regulations. You may bring in your own bedding, however a \$30 clean-out fee will be charged for bringing your own or purchasing less than the 5 bag minimum per stall. Stalls must have a cumulative 5 bags in each stall regardless of where your shavings come from to protect the stall floors.** Text (or call) Liz for stall and bedding orders at 303.520.4410.
5. Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A \$50.00 NSF fee will be charged.
6. Non-showing horses must pay an office fee, EMT fee and a grounds fee.

REGULATIONS

1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
2. No-judges will be allowed as long as time permits.
3. Hard hats and boots with a heel must be worn at all times by all riders while on show grounds.
4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 - 7:40 am. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class[es] should it be in the best interest of the show.
6. Only one horse per entry form.
7. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
8. Each class will award a first place trophy and ribbons through sixth place.
9. Champion and Reserve will be offered for all divisions.
10. Pets must be on a leash at all times!

BIOSECURITY AT THE COLORADO HORSE PARK

Current Health Certificate Requirements due to VSV in CO and region:

The following statement must be included on the health certificate: I have examined the animal(s) represented on this certificate of veterinary inspection and have found no clinical signs of vesicular stomatitis and they have not originated from a premises under quarantine for vesicular stomatitis

All documents must be in or include the horse's show name.

Additional Requirements for All Horses entering the showgrounds:

- Proof of EHV-1 & EHV-4 vaccination administered within the past six (6) months from arrival date
- A negative Coggins test dated within the past twelve (12) months from arrival date

Please ensure your horse's Health Certificate is issued **within seven (7) days of arrival** at the showgrounds to help avoid delays or entry issues.

Please be advised that equine entry requirements are subject to change as disease conditions evolve or as additional guidance is issued by the Show and CO State Veterinarian. We are monitoring the situation closely and will communicate any updates as soon as they become available.

We understand this update may require adjustments to your travel plans, and we sincerely apologize for any inconvenience. These requirements are in place to comply with current state veterinarian guidance and to help safeguard the health and well-being of every horse attending The Colorado Horse Park.

In response to the recent EHV-1 outbreak in California and similar cases reported in other states, the Colorado Horse Park is increasing biosecurity protocols to help keep your horses safe, as well as those of your fellow competitors.

Upon Arrival:

- Any horse on the show grounds with a fever must be reported to Management immediately. It is always better to err on the side of safety. Isolation stalls will either be available on the grounds and/or at a local veterinary practice if the need arises.

JUMPER \$50 STAKES CLASS

Classes 4, 7, 10, 13, 16, 19, 22. Entry Fee \$40

This fun class is a winner-take-all class that also counts for extra CHJA year-end points and towards your jumper division! First place receives the full \$50 Stakes money and a great prize and unique ribbon!

\$300 GOLD CREST TACK .85M TEAM RELAY – TEAM COSTUMES ENCOURAGED!

Class 301. Entry Fee \$60

Riders will start in a start box. The clock starts when Rider 1 crosses start timers in front of jump 1 carrying a baton. Rider 1 will complete the course then return to box and must hand off baton to Rider 2 while the clock is still running before Rider 2 can start the course. The clock stops when Rider 2 crosses the timers on the back side of last fence. While rails incur faults the same as the other jumper classes, refusals do not count off, but the clock keeps ticking. If a rider has 3 refusals at one fence, the team is eliminated. If the team has a cumulative 6 refusals, the team is eliminated. If a fence needs reset, clock stops, 6 seconds added then restart. Prize money divided to top three teams. \$150, \$100, \$50
