## SHOW RULES

Entries received after the pre-entry deadline will incur a \$25 post-entry fee. Entries will be accepted on the day of show. However, a \$25.00 day of show penalty will apply. Fees:

- Classes \$27 (\$2 tax deductible donation to CHJF for each class)
- Post Entry Fee \$25
- Day of Show Penalty \$25
- EMT Fee \$15 per rider
- Office Fee \$25 per entry
- Grounds Fee \$15
- A very limited number of pipe day pens are available for \$40 per day.
- All checks should be made payable to: GOLD CREST.
- Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A

\$50.00 NSF fee will be charged.

- Non-showing horses must pay an office fee, EMT fee and a grounds fee.

## REGULATIONS

1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.

- 2. No-judges will be allowed as long as time permits.
- 3. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on show grounds.

4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 - 7:50 am. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.

5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class[es] should it be in the best interest of the show.

6. Only one horse per entry form.

7. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.

- 8. Each class will award a first place trophy and ribbons through sixth place.
- 9. Champion and Reserve will be offered for all divisions.
- 10. Pets must be on a leash at all times.

## From the North:

Take i-25 south to Founders Parkway. Head east on Founders to 86. Take 86 east for 19.4 miles to the Messer Event Center on your left (north). There is a large boom truck parked by the sign at the driveway. Once on the dirt road, drive PAST the big indoor to enter the facility parking lot on the driveway behind the arena. Please park trailers backed in to spots perpendicular to the west side of the arena (This will seem evident when you are there!).



Take 24 east to Elbert Road. Take Elbert Road north 26.5 miles. Turn left onto 86 and the Messer Event Center will be 1.3 miles on the north side of the road. There is a large boom truck parked by the sign at the driveway. Once on the dirt lane, drive PAST the big indoor to enter the facility parking lot on the driveway behind the arena. Please park trailers perpendicular to the side of the arena.



# **COVID 19 PROTOCOL- ALL IN ATTENDANCE MUST READ:**

At Gold Crest we are trusting you to follow the below procedures in order to keep yourself and others at a minimized risk.

-All entries are to be made electronically through horseshowing.com or emailed to

coshowentries @gmail.com. No paper entries will be accepted at the horse show office.

-Please take your temperature in the morning and scratch your entry if you have a fever. Do not come if you have COVID-19 symptoms or if you have been exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19.


-Everyone should be mindful of space and keep a minimum of 6 feet away from any other person.

-Masks must be worn in close contact situations where a 6 foot distance may be difficult to maintain. Masks should be worn anywhere on the show grounds. If you can maintain an appropriate social distance by your trailer, you can take off the mask there in case of hot weather. Masks are not required to be worn by mounted riders.

-Trainer packets are to be picked up in the office by one representative and will only be handed out when all entries have a check attached. (Trainer may leave a barn check and will be responsible for any open accounts.)

- Rotations will be set up with the gate person on a first come first served basis. If you miss your rotation, or do not sign up for one, you will ride at the end of the division.

-The gate person has complete authority of the arena entrance and will manage the entrance to limit numbers.



-Only essential people may accompany horses to the warm-up area and back gate. This could include the trainer, a groom and one family member if the rider is a junior. All others should go directly from the trailer parking area to the viewing area at the show ring to watch their family member or barn mate compete.

-Due to COVID-19, show hospitality will be greatly limited this year. Complimentary water bottles will be available at certain locations, but you should plan to bring your own as paper cups and water dispensers will not be available at the back gate. No concessions will be offered at this show.
