Directions to Single Tree Farm

From the North: Take I-25 south. Take exit 236 onto SH-52 toward Fort Lupton. Keep right. Turn left onto N107. Turn right onto Arapahoe Rd. Facility will be on the left in about 3.5 miles. Follow long drive to the end. Turn left.

From the South: Take I-25 north towards Fort Collins. Take exit 217A on the left onto Hwy 36 west toward Boulder. Take exit for Wadsworth/287. Go north on 287. Turn left onto Arapahoe Rd. Facility will be on the left in about 3.5 miles. Follow long drive to the end. Turn left.

Rules and Regulations - Show will be run according to CHJA Rules & Regulations

Any entry received **after Wednesday, May 10th at 5 pm** will be assessed a \$25.00 late entry fee. Entries will be accepted on the day of the show; however, they will be assessed a \$25.00 day of show penalty fee.

ALL MONEY CLASSES MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF SIX RIDERS FOR PAYOUT.**

All fees should be made payable to Helicon Show Stables. No refunds will be given unless presented with a veterinarian's certificate. Returned checks will be assessed with a \$50.00 fee and must be paid in full in cash or certified funds within ten days.

Non-showing horses must enter the show and pay EMT, Office and Grounds Fees.

Paddocks will be available for a fee of \$35 per show day or \$60 from Fri-Sun. The stalls will not be bedded. Stabling is EXTREMELY limited! Please call/text Molly at 720-320-7362 to reserve a paddock.

Ride Did Not Enter fees are equal to two times the entry fee per class. This includes warm up classes. It is your responsibility to enter a class in the show office. The gate personnel may let you compete, but you must declare competing in the show office before you close out.

Regulations

1. Back-to-back rounds are allowed and encouraged.
2. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on show premises.
3. Schooling times may be limited if other horses are waiting.
4. Show management reserves the right to combine/cancel/divide any class(es) should it be in the best interest of the horse show.
5. Only one horse/rider combination per entry form.
6. One-minute gate, dotted line, and/or posted order of go may be imposed by show management in order to maintain reasonable pace for each ring.
7. Each class will be awarded ribbons first through sixth place. Warmups will be judged Blue/Red ribbon.
8. Champion and Reserve will be awarded in all divisions.
9. All dogs must remain on leashes at all times.
10. "No Judges" will be allowed

Payouts: All money classes must have 6 entries complete in order for the payout to be distributed. If there are not 6 entries, the class price will be reduced to the regular class fee and no money will be distributed.

Prize Money will be divided as follows: 30%, 23%, 18%, 14%, 10%, 5%

Health Requirements

A negative Coggins test within one year is required for all horses entering the facility.

AND

A vaccination record stating the animal has received regular and consistent vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 with most recent booster being within 180 days and not within 7 days. Written statements from Vet explaining reasons for being boosted with 180 days may be accepted. In no cases may the booster be within 7 days or outside of 180 days. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be denied entry to the competition grounds.

Horses may not have shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days. Horses may not have been at a facility under quarantine for EHV-4/1 or exposed to any horses showing symptoms of EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days.

Must be current on vaccinations against WNV, EEE, WEE. Tetanus and Rabies is recommended.

HELICON SPECIAL CLASSES

300. The Helicon Show Stables Equitation Flat Classic

-Entry fee: \$25 The Helicon Show Stables Equitation Flat Classic is open to any junior or amateur rider. To be eligible, riders must have competed in at least one other equitation class, over fences or on the flat, at the current Helicon show. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. Entries may be asked for any number of tests on the flat. No jumping. Entries will be brought to the middle of the ring one at a time until only the winner remains on the rail.

400. The Flying A Ranch \$250 Open Under Saddle Derby

-Entry fee: \$25 Open to any horse/pony and rider combination. To be eligible, horses/ponies must have shown in at least one other hunter class, over fences or under saddle, at the Helicon Show Stables CHJA or WPCSA show. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. Entries may be asked to hand gallop, but never more than eight at a time. Entries will be brought to the middle of the ring one at a time until only the winner remains on the rail. Ribbons 1st-6th and prize money payout for 6+ entries.

500. Horses Helping Humans Hunter Derby Class

Entry Fee-\$45 to be donated to members of the Colorado Equine Community in need of a helping hand.

Hunt and Go Format- judged utilizing the open numerical system to score competitors in the Classic Hunter Round (first round) on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. In addition, the base score in the Handy Hunter Round (second round) reflects brilliance of pace and handiness. In each round, after the judges' base score is given, one point will be added for each high-option fence jumped up to a maximum of four. The point must be added even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of

good jumping style at that fence, providing that the horse-and-rider combination does jump the higher height fence option.

Obstacles are reminiscent of the hunt field and must offer a variety of appearances, such as natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence or gate, coop, aiken, hedge, oxer, brush, logs and natural foliage. Natural obstacles such as banks and ditches are allowed. The Handy Hunter Round should simulate riding over hunt country and incorporate options such as tight turns, clever options for jump approaches, hand galloping and trotting a fence. Fences set at 2'3", with four high-option fences set at 2'9".

600. Horses Helping Humans Gambler's Choice Entry Fee-\$45 to be donated to members of the Colorado Equine Community in need of a helping hand.

You will have 50 seconds to ride your course. Make up your own course and be creative with your strategy!

- All jumps may be jumped from either direction.
- You may jump each jump twice.
- For each jump completed, you will receive the points assigned to that jump.
- No points are awarded for a fence if rails are knocked down.
- If you knock rails down, you may NOT jump that jump again.
- Refusals are not penalized (they just waste time).
- You must cross the time line at the beginning AND the end of your round. Ties will be awarded to the fastest one to reach the time line after the 50 second whistle is blown.
- JOKER FENCE:
 - ○ The Joker fence is OPTIONAL. It may ONLY be jumped after your round is complete. WAIT for the whistle to be blown again.
 - ○ You will have 20 seconds to complete the Joker fence, and you may only jump it once.
 - ○ You win 200 points if you jump it successfully, but you LOSE 200 points if you knock rails down or fail to jump it within the 20 seconds allowed.

BE SAFE. Reckless riding will get you disqualified!
