Rules and Regulations

Show will be run according to CHJA Rules & Regulations

Any entry received <u>after Tuesday, October 13th at 5 pm</u> will be assessed a \$25.00 late entry fee. Entries will be accepted on the day of the show; however, they will be assessed a \$25.00 day of show penalty fee.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A MONEY CLASS (STAKES/EQUITATION FLAT CLASSIC/COSTUME CLASS), THE HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION MUST HAVE SHOWN IN AT LEAST ONE OTHER NON-MONEY CLASS. PLEASE REVIEW INDIVIDUAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR MONEY CLASSES AS WELL. ALL MONEY CLASSES MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF SIX RIDERS FOR PAYOUT. STAKE PRIZE MONEY WILL BE DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 30%, 23%. 18%, 14%, 10%. 5%

All fees should be made payable to Helicon Show Stables. No refunds will be given unless presented with a veterinarian's certificate. Returned checks will be assessed a \$50.00 fee and must paid in full in cash or certified funds within ten days.

Non-showing horses must enter the show and pay EMT, Office and Grounds Fees.

Portable tent stalls are available but are limited. The stalls will not be bedded. Bedding will be available for purchase onsite. \$10/BAG. Please call Molly at 720-320-7362 to reserve a stall/pen.

Ride Did Not Enter fees are equal to two times the entry fee per class. This includes warm up classes. It is your responsibility to enter a class in the show office. The gate personnel may let you compete but you must declare competing in the show office before you close out.

Regulations

- 1. Back to back rounds are allowed and encouraged.
- 2. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on show premises.
- 3. Schooling times may be limited if other horses are waiting.
- 4. Show management reserves the right to combine/cancel/divide any class(es) should it be in the best interest of the horse show.
- 5. Only one horse/rider combination per entry form.

6. One-minute gate, dotted line, and/or posted order of go may be imposed by show management in order to maintain reasonable pace for each ring.

- 7. Each class will be awarded ribbons first through sixth place. Warm ups will be judged Blue/Red ribbon.
- 8. Champion and Reserve will be awarded in all divisions.
- 9. All dogs must remain on leashes at all times.
- 10. "No Judges" will be allowed

Health Requirements

A negative Coggins test within one year is required for all horses entering the facility.

AND

A vaccination record stating the animal has received regular and consistent vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 with most recent booster being within 180 days and not within 7 days. Written statements from Vet explaining reasons for being boostered with 180 days may be accepted. In no cases may the booster be within 7 days or outside of 180 days. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be denied entry to the competition grounds.

Horses may not have shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days. Horses may not have been at a facility under quarantine for EHV-4/1 or exposed to any horses showing symptoms of EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days.

Must be current on vaccinations against WNV, EEE, WEE. Tetanus and Rabies is recommended. PLEASE INCLUDE COGGINS & VACCINATION RECORD WITH YOUR ENTRY

COVID-19 PROTOCOL-All attending must read!

*Please remember that you are a guest at Helicon Show Stables and we take Covid-19 very seriously. We are trusting you to follow the below procedures in order to keep yourself and others at a minimized risk. Exhibitors and trainers, you are responsible for making sure everyone has read and complies with these provisions.

• All entries are to be made electronically through fax and e-mail

• Please take your temperature in the morning and scratch your entry if you have a fever!! Do not come if you have Covid-19 symptoms or have been exposed to a confirmed case of Covid-19.

• We request that you wash your hands immediately upon arrival and frequently throughout the day. Water and soap will be provided.

• Everyone should be mindful of space and keep a minimum of 6 feet away from any other person.

• Masks are to be worn at all times except when mounted. This includes everyone on Helicon Show Stables property.

• Trainer packets are to be picked up in the office by 1 representative and will only be handed out when all entries have a check attached. (Trainers may leave a barn check and will be responsible for any open accounts.

• The main barn and bathrooms are closed and are for boarders only. The indoor arena is to be accessed only through the east entrance.

• No ring side water will be offered at this show. No shade tents will be provided. Please bring your own chairs and shade.

MEDAL FINAL EXTRAVAGANZA

The CHJA Medal classes will be run as a separate class within the Medal Final Extravaganza class format. CHJA Medal classes will receive ribbons for 1st-6th place as well as applicable year end medal points. Medal Extravaganza classes will be a two (2) round format as well as a flat phase. The CHJA Medal will be the first round. Each round is scored and awarded placings 1st-6th. The scores for each round and the flat phase are then added together, and the overall winners are determined by the total scores. The overall Medal Extravaganza winners will receive special ribbons and prizes for placings 1st-6th.

\$500 Thalia & George Gentzel Memorial Hunt Team Costume Class – Entry fee: \$20 per team member

The Thalia & George Gentzel Memorial Hunt Team Class is open to ponies/horses who have competed in one of the regular hunter classes at the Helicon Fall Finale. Teams of 2-3 ponies/horses, shown over a course in the ring, one to follow the other at a safe hunting distance until the last fence where all 2-3 riders/ponies/horses will jump the final triple wide fence three abreast. Judged on performance, suitability, manners, uniformity, and appearance as a team. Costumes are <u>**HIGHLY**</u> recommended. Fences 2'0. Prize money divided \$250, \$150, \$100 to the top three.

\$300 Colorado Equestrian LLC Equitation Flat Classic – Entry Fee: \$45

The Helicon Show Stables Equitation Flat Classic is open to any junior or amateur rider. To be eligible, riders must have competed in at least one other equitation class, over fences or on the flat, at the Helicon Fall Finale. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. Entries may be asked for any number of tests on the flat. No jumping. Entries will be brought to the middle of the ring one at a time until only the winner remains on the rail. Prizes will be in the form of gift cards at \$150, \$100, \$50 to the top three


\$300 The Alcock Family Open Under Saddle Derby – Entry Fee: \$45

Open to any horse/pony and rider combination. To be eligible, horses must have shown in at least one other hunter class, over fences or under saddle, at the Helicon Fall Finale. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. Entries may be asked to hand gallop, but never more than eight at a time. Entries will be brought to the middle of the ring one at a time until only the winner remains on the rail. Prize money divided \$150, \$100, \$50 to the top three.
