## **BIOSECURITY AT THE COLORADO HORSE PARK**

### Required:

Negative Coggins within one year.

Health Certificate within 10 days. This should include dates of vaccinations no later than 180 days)

Vaccine records stating that EHV 1/4 were administered no later than 180 days prior to the show.

### ***ALL PAPERWORK MUST BE IN THE HORSE'S SHOW NAME!***

Friday entry must occur by appointment only.

Saturday and Sunday entrance 6:00 am – 2:00pm

ENTRIES MUST BE SENT ELECTRONICALLY EITHER BY CLEAN, CLEAR SCANS OR BY [WWW.HORSESHOWING.COM](http://WWW.HORSESHOWING.COM) **DARK AND BLURRY CELL PHONE PHOTOS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. A \$10 FEE FOR FILLING OUT AN ENTRY WILL APPLY.** If you do not pre-enter, your entry may be rejected. If there is room in the show we will fill the form out for you and there will be a charge for that.

### Dogs and Pets:

Pets must be on a leash at all times. Dogs found loose on the property will be picked up. The owner must pay a \$90.00 fine before the pet will be released. Douglas County Animal Control does patrol the grounds regularly.

### Stabling & Bedding

Stalls MUST be reserved by phone. Stall Fees: \$45.00 per day \$90 for 2 days. Stalls are available from Friday at 2:00pm through Sunday afternoon. Stalls are permanent with doors. There will be bedding and hay available at the show. Order your bedding early by calling 303-910-9410. If a horse shows both days and has requested a stall, 2 days stall will be charged. Prices are subject to change. A minimum of 4 bags of bedding must be put in the stalls. A cleaning fee will be charged if you bring your own bedding.

### Hard Hats

All riders, while riding anywhere on the show grounds, must wear protective headgear which meets USEF standards. Any rider violating this rule will be prohibited from riding until his or her headgear is properly in place. Adults are required to wear hard hats.

### ENTRY PROCEEDURES

Entries, submitted online, emailed or faxed must be received by 8:00 pm Thursday or Late Fees will be charged. No money need be sent in advance. On the day of show make any changes before picking up your number. After picking up your number you are financially responsible for your entries. No extra charge for adding classes as long as you add them prior to riding in the class. Classes may **NOT** be added at the gate. You must add in the office or by text to the office. If you find you can not come to the show after entering, call the show office at 303-910-9410. After picking up your number there will be no refunds without a veterinary certificate. All horses on the grounds must pay a grounds fee or a stall fee whether showing or not. All riders on the grounds must pay an EMT fee whether showing or not. All horses entered must pay an office fee regardless of whether they went in a single class.

### DAY OF SHOW SCHOOLING

A limited number of horses will be allowed in the arena at one time. Schooling on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting. Schooling will be permitted from 6:30am until prior to the start of each ring. No charge for schooling Saturday or Sunday.

### RETURNED CHECKS

There will be a \$50.00 charge for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 5 days to be paid in full by cash or cash equivalent.

### AWARDS AND CHAMPIONSHIPS

First place trophy and ribbons to sixth place. Division championships will be awarded.

**Red/Blue Warm up** - Open to all horses and ponies. Fences will change with division heights. Courses may be changed or adjusted during the show. Warm up may be closed during flat classes and during some classes which will be announced. PLEASE pay attention to the warm up close announcements. Horses and ponies will be judged and given a numeric score. A score of 80-100 will earn a blue award. Scores from 70-79 will earn a red award.

**FRIDAY SCHOOLING WILL BE AVAILABLE** - Schooling spots must be reserved in advance by the trainer before noon Thursday. All spots reserved will be charged to the trainer and are non-refundable. Trainers may split these to their riders if done so in the show office before 10:00 am Saturday. Even if the trainer does not come to the show these charges will be billed and must be paid. There must be a minimum of 25 horses signed up by the deadline or it will be canceled. Notice of cancellation will appear on [www.kenneyshow.com](http://www.kenneyshow.com) by Thursday night. Schooling reservations must be in writing by email or fax. No phone reservations. The names of the riders/horses must be included for billing purposes. Sessions will cost \$25.00 per horse. Time of session will be determined by the number of horses needing to get in the ring.

## **MRC Summer's End COVID-19 Protection Plan – All in attendance must read.**

Please remember you are a guest of Meridian Riding Club and the Colorado Horse Park. COVID-19 is serious, and we must put forth this protocol to keep horse shows running! By signing your or your child's entry, you are agreeing to the protocol put forth in this prize list and all signage posted on the show grounds. If you cannot comply with these regulations, please do not enter the show. Failure to follow these regulations will result in your dismissal from the grounds with no refunds due to you.

- Water taps are provided but use them at your own risk. You should bring water in your own containers when possible. Hoses will not be available at water taps or wash racks – please bring your own. Please sanitize hands after touching any surface that is publicly available.
- There may be a posted order or scheduled blocks at all arenas. DO NOT cluster at the gates. The starter at each gate is in absolute control of that ring and has the final say in all starting orders. If you miss your rotation – you will be moved to the end of the order.
- Spectators are asked to stay away. Only trainers, exhibitors and parents should be on the grounds. Please vacate the grounds once you are done for the day.
- Social distancing is always required.
- A limited number of people will be allowed to school at one time. Wait for your turn without crowding the gate.
- Trainers and their assistants are required to wear gloves in the schooling area when adjusting fences.
- Maintain 2 fence posts distance between people at the arena.
- MASKS ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN MOUNTED!
- Please take your temperature each morning. Scratch if you have a fever or if you have had any exposure to a confirmed COVID-19 case.
- Please wash your hands frequently throughout the day. Sanitizer will be available at various places throughout the showgrounds and soap will be available in the permanent bathrooms. We encourage you to bring your own cleaning and sanitizing supplies to help!
- All entry forms must be transmitted electronically. If you show up without having done that, the secretary will fill one out for you in the office and you will be charged \$10 for that service. PLEASE pay in cash if possible – it can be sanitized. Checks will be accepted. Venmo will also be made available.
- Trainers are encouraged to take care of all office business for their barn accounts to cut down on traffic in the office. Trainers will be given a packet when they check in. No numbers will be issued without payment. Trainers may leave a barn check and will be responsible for any open accounts. Trainers – please encourage your clients to use Venmo or bring cash.
- Be aware that last minute changes are possible. Arenas and stabling included

REMINDER – these requirements are put forth by USEF, CHJA, and State and County mandates. **Please, please, please** adhere to them so that we may continue to enjoy our wonderful sport and support the facilities and managements that are willing to stick their necks out there for YOU – THE EXHIBITOR!
