SHOW RULES

Entries will be accepted on the day of show. However, a \$25.00 day of show penalty will apply after the closing date.

Fees:

- Regular classes \$30.00
- Medal Classes \$30.00
- Post Entry Fee \$25.00
- Day of Show Penalty \$25.00
- EMT Fee \$15.00 per rider
- Office Fee \$30.00 per entry
- Stalls \$50 per day
- Grounds Fee \$30.00 non-stabled horses

1. All entry forms must be transmitted electronically. All fees should be made payable to: **MRC Horse Show. VENMO WILL BE AVAILABLE!!! Cash or Venmo are preferred.** Checks also accepted.

2. **No refunds will be given unless accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate.**

3. Stalls will be available per show day. The stalls will not be bedded. Bedding will be available, please call to reserve stalls and order bedding. Carole - 303-910-9410 All stalls are required to have a four bag minimum per CHP regulations. ALL BEDDING MUST BE PRE-ORDERED. You may bring in your own bedding however a \$25 fee will be charged for bringing your own or purchasing less than the 4 bag minimum per stall. No feed or hay will be available on grounds.

Stall charges as follows:

1 DAY (NO OVERNIGHT) \$50

2 DAY/ 1 NIGHT \$95

ENTIRE WEEKEND (FRIDAY-SUNDAY) \$135

Regulations:

1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
2. No-judges will be allowed if time permits.
3. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on Colorado Horse Park property.
4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 am until 30 minutes prior to the start of the ring. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class(es) should it be in the best interest of the show.
6. Only one horse per entry form.
7. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show.
8. Each class will award a first place trophy and ribbons through sixth place. Champion and Reserve will be offered for all divisions.
9. There will be a \$50.00 charge for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 5 days to be paid in full by cash or equivalent.
10. Pets must be on a leash at all times!
11. Non-showing horses must be entered and pay a grounds fee, an emt fee and an office fee.

ENTRY PROCEDURES: Entries must be received by 8:00 pm Thursday the 6th to avoid the Post Entry Fee. If you enter on the day of show, an additional Day Of Show Fee will be charged. On the day of show make any changes before picking up your number. After picking up your number you are financially responsible for your entries. No extra charge for adding classes as long as you add them prior to riding in the class. Classes may **NOT** be added at the gate. You must add and scratch in the office PRIOR to the start of the class or you will be charged.

For all rated classes please view rules and specs in the CHJA Rulebook. The Rulebook is also available online at www.chja.org.

FRIDAY SCHOOLING WILL BE AVAILABLE - Schooling spots must be reserved in advance by the trainer before noon Thursday. All spots reserved will be charged to the trainer and are non-refundable. Trainers may split these to their riders if done so in the show office before 10:00 am Saturday. Schooling reservations must be in writing by email or text. No phone reservations. The names of the riders/horses must be included for billing purposes. Sessions will cost \$30.00 per horse. Time of session will be determined by the number of horses needing to get in the ring. **Schooling 1:00pm – 6pm.**

BIOSECURITY AT THE COLORADO HORSE PARK

Required:

Negative Coggins within one year.

Health Certificate within 30 days. This should include dates of vaccinations no later than 180 days) If there is an outbreak of equine disease in the area the Health Cert time frame MAY be reduced to 10 days.

Vaccine records stating that EHV 1/4 were administered no later than 180 days prior to the show.

ALL PAPERWORK MUST BE IN THE HORSE'S SHOW NAME! No horse can be unloaded until the paperwork is turned in. No stall assignments will be given out in advance. Stalls will be given by the show office upon arrival.

All horses must enter the facility off Bayou Gulch Rd. There will only be one entrance open and it will be the first one you come to across from the church. **No entrance through the top gate on S. Pinery Dr.**

Friday entry must occur by appointment only. Saturday and Sunday entrance 6:00 am – 2:00pm

PRE-CHECK WILL BE AVAILABLE AND STRONGLY ENCOURAGED!!!!

MRC Summer's End COVID-19 Protection Plan – All in attendance must read. Please remember you are a guest of Meridian Riding Club and the Colorado Horse Park. COVID-19 is serious, and we must put forth this protocol to keep horse shows running! By signing your or your child's entry, you are agreeing to the protocol put forth in this prize list and all signage posted on the show grounds. If you cannot comply with these regulations, please do not enter the show. Failure to follow these regulations will result in your dismissal from the grounds with no refunds due to you.

- Water taps are provided but use them at your own risk. You should bring water in your own containers when possible. Hoses will not be available at water taps or wash racks – please bring your own. Please sanitize hands after touching any surface that is publicly available.
- There may be a posted order or scheduled blocks at all arenas. DO NOT cluster at the gates. The starter at each gate is in absolute control of that ring and has the final say in all starting orders. If you miss your rotation – you will be moved to the end of the order.
- Spectators are asked to stay away. Only trainers, exhibitors and parents should be on the grounds. Please vacate the grounds once you are done for the day.
- Social distancing is always required.
- A limited number of people will be allowed to school at one time. Wait for your turn without crowding the gate.
- Trainers and their assistants are required to wear gloves in the schooling area when adjusting fences.
- Maintain 2 fence posts distance between people at the arena.
- MASKS ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN MOUNTED!
- Please take your temperature each morning. Scratch if you have a fever or if you have had any exposure to a confirmed COVID-19 case.
- Please wash your hands frequently throughout the day. Sanitizer will be available at various places throughout the showgrounds and soap will be available in the permanent bathrooms. We encourage you to bring your own cleaning and sanitizing supplies to help!
- All entry forms must be transmitted electronically. If you show up without having done that, the secretary will fill one out for you in the office and you will be charged \$10 for that service. PLEASE pay in cash if possible – it can be sanitized. Checks will be accepted. Venmo will also be made available.
- Trainers are encouraged to take care of all office business for their barn accounts to cut down on traffic in the office. Trainers will be given a packet when they check in. No numbers will be issued without payment. Trainers may leave a barn check and will be responsible for any open accounts. Trainers – please encourage your clients to use Venmo or bring cash.
- Be aware that last minute changes are possible. Arenas and stabling included

REMINDER – these requirements are put forth by USEF, CHJA, and State and County mandates. **Please, please, please** adhere to them so that we may continue to enjoy our wonderful sport and support the facilities and managements that are willing to stick their necks out there for YOU – THE EXHIBITOR!
