SHOW RULES

Entries received after the pre-entry deadline will incur a \$25 post-entry fee. Entries will be accepted on the day of show. However, a \$25.00 day of show penalty will apply.

Fees:

- Classes \$25
- Gold Crest Tack Derby \$35
- MJE Jump Construction Derby \$40
- Jackpot Mini Prix \$40
- Post Entry Fee \$25
- Day of Show Penalty \$25
- EMT Fee \$15 per rider
- Office Fee \$25 per entry
- Grounds Fee \$15
- Stall Fee \$40 per DAY (4 bag minimum per stall)
- Shavings \$10.50/bag
- **COVID STALL CHARGE** \$10 (If you strip your stall to the point that it doesn't appear to have been used, you will not have to pay the \$10 covid stall cleaning charge.)

- All checks should be made payable to: GOLD CREST.

- Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A \$50.00 NSF fee will be charged.

- Non-showing horses must pay an office fee, EMT fee and a grounds fee.

REGULATIONS

1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
2. No-judges will be allowed as long as time permits.
3. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on show grounds.
4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 - 7:50 am. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class[es] should it be in the best interest of the show.
6. Only one horse per entry form.
7. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
8. Each class will award a first place trophy and ribbons through sixth place.
9. Champion and Reserve will be offered for all divisions.
10. Pets must be on a leash at all times.

BIOSECURITY AT THE COLORADO HORSE PARK REQUIRED:

1. A current negative Coggins test
 2. Vaccination records showing date of vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 (booster must be within 180 days)
 3. Health certificate dated by a licensed veterinarian within 10 days of arriving at the venue**
- WNV,
EEE, WEE, Tetanus and Rabies are strongly recommended.
Horses may not unload until paperwork is approved. All horses must enter the facility off Bayou Gulch Road. There will only be one entrance open and it will be the first entry east of Ponderosa School and across from the church.
No entrance for horse show trailers through the top gate on South Pinery Dr.

COVID 19 PROTOCOL- ALL IN ATTENDANCE MUST READ:

At Gold Crest we are trusting you to follow the below procedures in order to keep yourself and others at a minimized risk.

-All entries are to be made electronically through horseshowing.com or emailed to coshowentries@gmail.com. No paper entries will be accepted at the horse show office.

-Please take your temperature in the morning and scratch your entry if you have a fever. Do not come if you have COVID-19 symptoms or if you have been exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19.

-Everyone should be mindful of space and keep a minimum of 6 feet away from any other person.

- **Masks must be worn anywhere on the show grounds.** Masks are not required to be worn by mounted riders.

-Trainer packets are to be picked up in the office by one representative and will only be handed out when all entries have a check attached. (Trainer may leave a barn check and will be responsible for any open accounts.)

- Rotations will be set up with the gate person on a first come first served basis. If you miss your rotation, or do not sign up for one, you will ride at the end of the division.

-The gate person has complete authority of the arena entrance and will manage the entrance to limit numbers.

-Only essential people may accompany horses to the warm-up area and back gate. This could include the trainer, a groom and one family member if the rider is a junior. All others should go directly from the trailer parking area to the viewing area at the show ring to watch their family member or barn mate compete. Please maintain responsible social distancing in the viewing areas!

-Due to COVID-19, show hospitality will be greatly limited this year. Complimentary water bottles will be available at certain locations, but you should plan to bring your own as paper cups and water dispensers will not be available at the back gate.

-No outside spectators allowed. Only competitors, parents and trainers, please. All ringside watching should be done as spaced out as possible.

This performance hunter class presents competitors an opportunity to best showcase the talents of horse and rider over a challenging course with performance and handy options. The class combines a Hunter Classic with a Handy Hunter class in a one round format.

Judging: Each competitor receives a score with 3 components:

1. Hunter score (out of 100) - The class is judged as a handy hunter class with a score
2. Performance bonus - One bonus point awarded for each high performance option taken on course.
3. Handy bonus (up to 10 bonus points) – Zero to ten additional bonus points awarded at the judge's discretion for additional handiness and high performance displayed on course, including: Unique turns and approaches, inside turns, athleticism and boldness impressionable start and finish.

This performance hunter class presents competitors an opportunity to best showcase the talents of horse and rider over a challenging course with performance and handy options. The class combines a Hunter Classic with a Handy Hunter class in a one round format.

Judging: Each competitor receives a score with 3 components:

1. Hunter score (out of 100) - The class is judged as a handy hunter class with a score
2. Performance bonus - One bonus point awarded for each high performance option taken on course.
3. Handy bonus (up to 10 bonus points) – Zero to ten additional bonus points awarded at the judge's discretion for additional handiness and high performance displayed on course, including: Unique turns and approaches, inside turns, athleticism and boldness impressionable start and finish.

JACKPOT VARIABLE MINI PRIX

Class 203. Entry Fee \$40

The Mini Prix will be ridden in variable heights. Each rider/horse combination must compete in at least 2 qualifying classes at the fence height they wish to ride the Mini Prix. The fence height may be any jumper division starting from a minimum of .85M (2'9").

For each horse entered, \$10 will be added back into the Jackpot. Prize money will be divided from the Jackpot to the top 8: 30%, 20%, 15%, 10%, 10%, 5%, 5%, 5%.
