**From I25 North:** take Lincoln Avenue exit. Turn east to Parker Road, make the right onto Parker Road and continue through town.

**From I25 South:** Take Castle Pines Parkway exit. Turn east to Parker Road, make the right on to Parker Road and continue through town.

**For Barn A or Day Trailer Parking:** Continue on Parker Road, to the high school (red LED sign) and make a left onto Bayou Gulch Road. Follow the signs to the park. Barn A will be the closest to the rings and the housing development.

**For Upper Barn Stabling:** Turn left off of Parker Road on to South Pinery Parkway, then make a right on to South Pinery Drive. Follow the signs. Barn 1 is closest to the arenas, Barn 4 is closest to the paddocks.

#### For Day Trailer and Barn A stalls:

Please know that the Colorado Horse Park is also hosting a Carriage Driving show at the same facility that weekend. Be aware that you may encounter horses and carriages on the way to and from the rings. Paths will be set to avoid cross-over where possible, but in some areas it will be unavoidable.

- -Ticketed Schooling: \$10 per ring. Friday's schedule is ticketed schooling only. Saturday, and Sunday morning schooling will be held from 7:00 to 7:45 weather permitting. Morning schooling time per horse may be limited if horses are waiting.
- -Pro Equitation Challenge: No Entry Fee

-Late Fee: \$25

-Stalls:

-Trailer-In Facility Fee: \$40 per entry

- -All checks made payable to Colorado Show Circuit
- -Checks, Venmo, and PayPal accepted. Credit cards not accepted.
- -Returned checks must be paid in cash or by cashiers check within 30 days of notification plus a \$50 fee.
- -Non-showing horses must pay a office, EMT, and stall/trailer-in fees

### **Competition Rules**

- -Back to back rounds are allowed and encouraged.
- -No-judge Rounds will be allowed as long as time permits.

If in a division in which the horse is competing, the judged round will be the first round but no-judge rounds are permitted after that one.

- -Helmets must be worn at all times while on competition grounds.
- -Numbers must be worn at all times while mounted.
- -Competition management has the right to cancel, combine or divide any class(es), should it be in the best interest of the show.

## -Management may move classes to a different ring at any time deemed necessary.

- -Only one horse per entry.
- -Pets must be kept on a leash at all times
- -Champion and Reserve will be offered in all divisions.
- -First place recipients (all divisions) will choose from the prize table.

#### **Special Classes:**

**Gamblers' Choice:** Jumps will be assigned a value on the course chart, riders will have 60 seconds from crossing the start markers to get as many points as possible. Jumps may only be jumped twice. All jumps may be jumped in either direction. If a jump comes down it may not be attempted again. At 60 seconds a buzzer will sound and riders must get to the finish timer line. The points for the last jump will only count if the horse has left the ground when the buzzer sounds. Class will be ranked by the most points, in the case of equal points ties will be broken by the time. Fences to be 1.0m. The joker fence will be 1.10m and riders will have 45 seconds to make an attempt at it. A rail or refusal will result in -200 points, clearing the fence will add 200 points to the score. Prizes are ribbons and \$100 to winner, \$50 to second place.

**Jumper Relay**: Two riders will be on a team. The course will be 12 jumps. Each horse must jump 6 jumps. These may be in any combination chosen by the team as long as all 12 jumps are jumped in order and each horse jumps 6 jumps. (example: Horse 1 does 1 - 6 and Horse 2 does 7 - 12, or Horse 1 does 1 - 4, Horse 2 does 1 - 3, Horse 2 does 4 - 9, Horse 1 does 10 - 12, etc) Faults and refusals will count as normal. Fences will be at 1.0m. Prizes are ribbons and \$200 to winning team and \$100 to second place.

**Double Derby:** This class will not be held separately. Teams must be submitted to the office by 8:00 Sunday morning. Teams may be any two horse/rider combinations (but may not be same rider on multiple horses) Teams are of two horse/rider combinations that may be from different heights or the same height. Results will be based on combined first round scores. Prizes will be ribbons and \$200 to winning team, \$100 to second place team.

**Pro Equitation Challenge:** No entry fee. This class is restricted to professionals. It will be held in the hunter ring and judged by two judges. Scores will be a combination of a general equitation score and a bonus 1 – 10 score based on the most creative, well executed equitation course. Some oxers may only be jumped a certain direction and riders will be responsible for adhering to this. Courses are to be 8 – 12 fences, penalties will be assessed for too many or too few fences. A party will be held in the pavilion above Coors during this class.

**Assisted Riding Classes:** There will be one flat class and two over poles classes Friday and Saturday. These classes will be open to riders needing leading or other assistance.

**Champion and Reserves:** Jumper Champion and Reserves will based on the six classes held over Saturday and Sunday, entry in all classes is not required to be eligible. Sunday's final II.2.B will be the tie break in case of ties. If that does not break the tie previous II.2.Bs will be used in reverse chronological order.

Every entry at a recognized competition shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that all participants (which include, without limitation, the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider, handler and the horse), For themselves, their principles, representatives, employees and agents: (1) Shall be subject to the constitution and rules of CSC, CHJA, CHP and CEP and the local rules of the competition; (2) Represent that every horse, rider, driver, and handler is eligible as entered; (3) Agree to be bound by the constitution and rules of CSC, CHJA, CHP and CEP and of the competition, and will accept as final the decision of CSC, CHP and CEP on any question arising under said rules, and agree to hold the competition, CHP, CEP their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken; (4) Agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, they authorize CSC, CHJA, CHP & CEP and/or the competition management to market, transfer, assign or otherwise make any use of any photographs, likenesses, films, broadcast, cablecasts, audiotapes, or videotapes taken of the horses(s) and participant(s) while on the grounds, incident to, on in transit between the stabling facility and the event site, in any way they see fit for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the event, sport, CSC, CHJA, CHP or CEP, without compensation to any of them, so long as the use neither jeopardizes amateur state nor endorses a specific product or service, and hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such, including any claim to invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation; and (5) Agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk of serious injury or death, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of injury or loss, and they agree to hold CSC, CHJA, CHP, CEP, the competition and their officials, directors, employees and agent harmless from and against all claims including claims based on negligence, breach of contract, strict liability and/or otherwise for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the competition, officials, directors, employees or agents of CSC, CHJA, CHP, CEP or competition. The construction and application of CSC, CHJA, CEP and CEP rules are governed by the laws of the State of Colorado, and any action instituted against CSC and/or CHJA and/or CHP and/or CEP must be filed in the State of Colorado.
