Safety Cups

As of December 1, 2008, CHJA will require Safety Cups on the back rail of all oxers in all competition rings. In addition, Safety Cups must be available on request for warm up and schooling areas (Rule 3.11). CHJA has purchased 14 pairs of breakaway cups and is making them available at no cost to CHJA approved horse shows.

The set consists of seven shallow and seven regular depth pairs of cups. These cups are fashioned to use on conventional jump standards and do not require special channels or fittings.

In order to borrow the set, the show manager needs to contact either Roland Connors or Carole Kenney to arrange delivery. At delivery, the manager will sign an agreement acknowledging receipt of the cups, agreeing to be responsible for loss or damage, and establishing their return date. This step is important because CHJA member shows are occasionally less than a week apart during the spring and summer.

The CHJA Board hopes that this program will make your shows easier and safer.
