

Show Assignment Policy

The policy below will be used for dates which open due to loss of seniority. "New" show dates are obtained according to Rule 2.1 F. Anyone requesting a new show date may select from all remaining dates on a first come first served basis. No new show dates may be added after May 1st of the competition year. Any manager may also ask to pick up a canceled show date during the competition year through the Show Standards Chair, per Rule 3.11.

Policy: A lottery system will be used to assign show dates which open due to loss of seniority.
(See Rules 2.2 and 2.3 B for information on Loss of Seniority)

Procedure:

1. After November 1, the Show Standards Chair will compile a list of dates which have opened due to loss of seniority.
2. The Show Standards Chair will send the list of open dates and a Lottery Application to anyone who has expressed interest in the lottery and to all current managers. The information will also be placed on the CHJA Web Site.
3. Individuals interested in obtaining show dates which have opened complete a Lottery Application which can be obtained from the Show Standards Chair. The application is submitted without fees to the Show Standards Chair.
4. Applications are divided into three pools:
The first pool is applicants who do not currently have a show date.
The second pool is applicants who have only one current show date.
The third pool is applicants who currently have multiple show dates.
5. An application is drawn from the first pool. That applicant is offered the date or dates available. The applicant can accept the date (or select one of the dates if more than one is available), or decline the date or dates offered. If necessary, the process is repeated until all of the applicants in the first pool are exhausted. If dates are still available, the lottery continues from the second pool, and if necessary into the third pool.
